A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In October, we began a feasibility study to determine whether the parish would support the renovation of our gym and cafeteria. As you know, these are the two remaining parts of our original campus, built in 1950. The gym was our original church.

Both the gym and the cafeteria have several areas that need fixed and updated. Some issues need to be addressed immediately, including the roof, heating and cooling systems, and structural issues. Other areas are more cosmetic, but if we are to continue using the spaces, they need to be updated. It makes no sense to change the immediate needs without addressing the longer-term needs of both spaces.

The parish had a great response to the feasibility study, and we have received the final results.



In total, over 300 surveys were returned, and 120 conversations were conducted with parishioners! The organization helping us with this study, Kirby-Smith, said they have not really seen this kind of response from a parish our size. They believe, with this response, we have a representative sample for the entire parish.

Overall, the parish is very supportive of the plans for renovation. Over 90% are either “Very supportive” or “supportive,” and another 7% is “somewhat supportive.” Only 1% was not supportive. That is overwhelming support, although I value everyone’s opinion, even those who do not agree, and will take their objections into consideration as plans are developed.

As for a proposed 3-year capital campaign for the estimated \$3.7M project, similarly, 90% are “Very Supportive” or “Supportive” of such a campaign.

The survey also asked, preliminarily, what people might consider giving. I can’t thank you enough for your generosity throughout the year. Because of it, our parish is in very healthy financial shape. As a pastor, you have made the financial management of the parish very easy. You are so generous and always respond to any need.

And your response to this study was equally as generous. Kirby-Smith believes that, with your response and generosity, and what we could raise in addition from other sources, we will raise enough to successfully complete the project.

The next steps:

Because of the feasibility study, we are presenting the plans for our project and the completed study to the Diocese. There are several committees that need to approve them, including the Diocesan Building Commission and the College of Consultors (a board of priests who advises Bishop Senior).

Those meetings will happen this month. If we are given the go-ahead by those committees, we will begin our capital campaign. We will need your help with this campaign. Several people wrote on their survey that they’d be interested in serving on a capital campaign committee. Others will be needed for other committees. Even if you did not already state your willingness to serve, perhaps you’d like to serve as well?

I will continue to keep you updated on this exciting project. The timeline for this project has not yet been determined, but once the Diocese gives us initial approval, we will have a better idea of when we can start raising funds, and when we could potentially begin construction work.

God bless you, and thank you for your Faith. It is this Faith that you desire to continue living out here at Seven Sorrows. With this project, Seven Sorrows will be stronger and more able to live out our mission to proclaim Jesus Christ and His saving mysteries to everyone in our parish! Please pray for the project, and that God’s will be done.
