## 1. ACCESSING YOUTH PROTECTION PROGRAM TRAINING AND LEARNING SITE

#### 2. ACCESSING CHILD RECOGNITION AND REPORTING CHILD ABUSE TRAINING

The Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse training is a <u>3-hour online course</u> which is free of charge to assist individuals in compliance with the training requirements under Act 31.

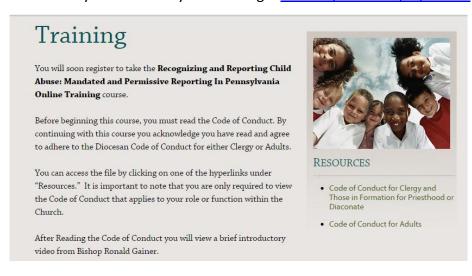
If a Member should not finish the course in one session, he/she can <u>exit at any time and</u> <u>resume where he/she left off</u> when logging in at a later date.

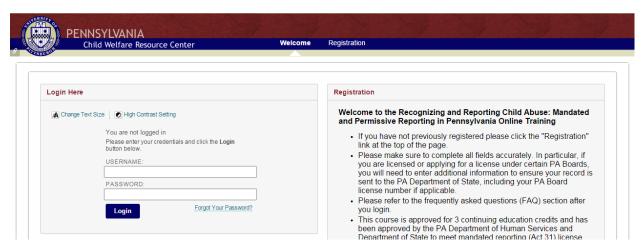

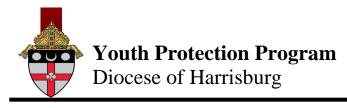

- d. Register as a New User with the PA CWRC
  - i. Select "Registration" at the top center of the naviation bar

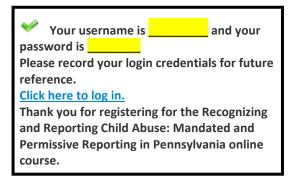


- ii. Enter personal information in fields provided. All fields in **blue** are <u>required</u> to be completed
- iii. Select Submit

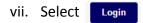


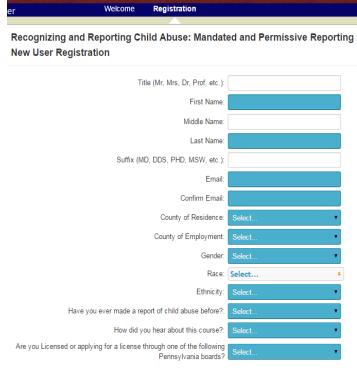
iv. A <u>username</u> and <u>password</u> (highlighted in yellow) will be assigned at the bottom of the "New User Registration" page, and an email containing the assigned username and password will be emailed to the Member's registered email address

\*NOTE: Members <u>should</u> make a record of their login and password, in the circumstance an email is not received from PA CWRC



- v. Select "Welcome" at the tob center of the navigation bar to return o the main PA CWRC page
- vi. Enter *Username* and *Password* which was assigned by PA CWRC

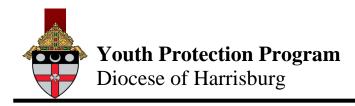

- viii. Select the <u>rrca-0652</u>: <u>Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse</u> link under "Your Courses" and begin the training
  - ix. After course completion, the Member should either <u>print</u> or <u>save an electronic copy</u> of the Certificate of Completion to be submitted to the Local Administrator of his/her Location



### 3. FORGOT YOUR PASSWORD?

a. Select "Forgot Your Password?" link below the Username and Password fields of the "Login Here" box.

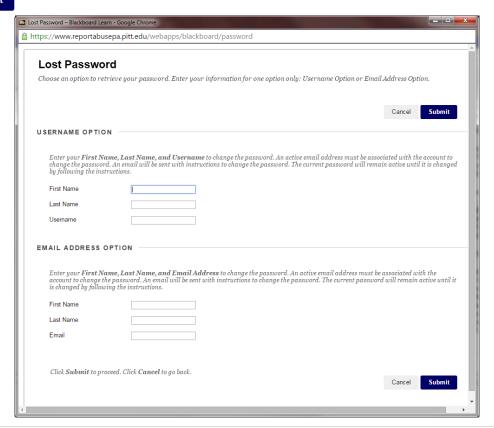
- b. A separate webpage browser will pop-up:
  - i. Username Option if the Member does not know his/her PA CWRC password, but can recall the assigned username, complete the following fields: First Name, Last Name and Username

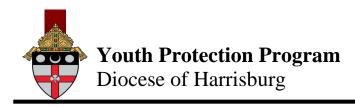


ii. Email Address Option – if the Member does not know his/her PA CWRC assigned password AND password, complete the following fields:
First Name, Last Name and Email

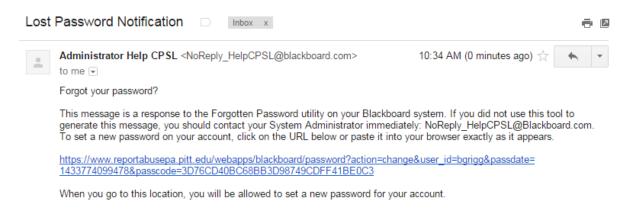
c. Select

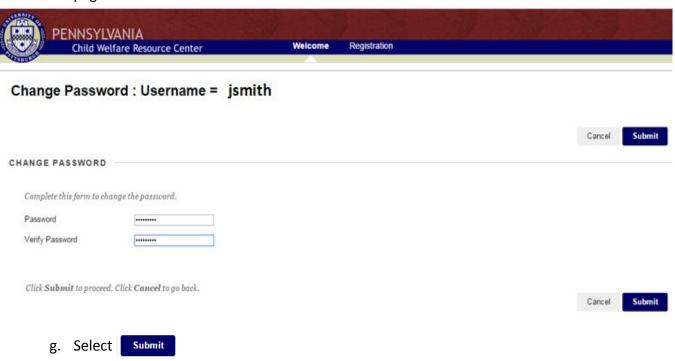




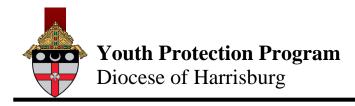
- d. The Member should check his/her registered email address for an email notification from Administrator Help CPSL
- e. Select the *URL link* in the email recived from Administrator Help CPSL regarding the Forgotten Password



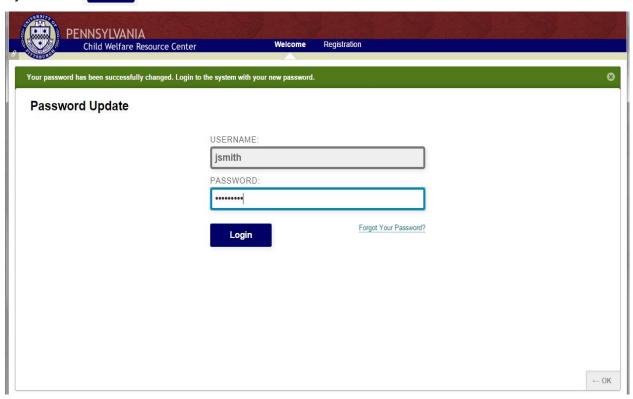
f. Enter the new *Password* and re-enter to *Verify Password* on PA CWRC "Change Password" page



h. If the Member has successfully changed his/her password, a message in <u>green</u> will appear at the top of the CWRC page under the navigation bar stating, "Your Password has been successfully changed. Login to the system with your new password."



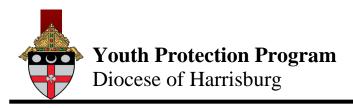
- i. Enter registered Username and new Password
- j. Select Login
