



## What is SST?

The goal of the SST is to review the concerns of the classroom teacher and the student's parents/guardians and to develop an action plan that will address those concerns.

## Who is on the team?

The SST is staffed by individuals most directly involved in the student's life.

Team members include:

parents/guardians, classroom teacher, principal, and instructional support teacher. In addition, support teachers from the Capital Area Intermediate (CAIU) such as the school counselor, speech and language clinician, and reading specialist.

# What services are available K - 8 ?

- Classroom interventions
- Consultative support for teachers in the area of occupational therapy and ELL
- Speech & Language Services provided by CAIU
- Remedial Reading and Mathematics services provided by the CAIU. Service provided outside the classroom setting.
- School Counseling Services
- Instructional Support Teacher provides support for the student along with the classroom teacher; and is able to work with students one on one as well as in the classroom setting.

Some services can only be obtained with qualifying results from a Full Psychological Evaluation or a diagnosis from a medical professional.

## What is the process?

### Initiating a Meeting

- Classroom teacher or parent(s) can request a meeting in writing if they have reason for concerns.
- Individuals who request the referral must complete a referral form.
- A date is set and the team is notified.
- Parent and classroom teacher are asked to complete a survey describing their child's strengths and area of concerns prior to the meeting date.

### Meeting Agenda

- The team will present the information obtained on the individual and review the referral form.
- Provide opportunity for comments and questions.
- Team will present a recommendation and give time for discussion to come to consensus.
- Make recommendations to the teacher to help improve the student's performance.
- Recommendation of testing for a specific learning need may be determined at this time.
