

 - Set up your account using SSBVM's enrollment code: LE4445641L54
 - Buy gift cards for groceries, gas, dining, and shopping
 - · Use them like cash in stores or online
 - Earn tuition credit automatically!

Real Life Example:

 $\$100 \rightarrow \3.50 tuition back $\rightarrow \$420$ /year tuition savings



Kids always seem hungry, right? When you spend \$100 at Giant using RaiseRight, you get 3.5% back—thats \$3.50 going toward your tuition!
