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



ATTENDANCE SNAPSHOT

SSVBM ATTENDANCE POLICY

Per state law, SSBVM Students must attend school regularly. Students need to be in attendance prior to 11:30 a.m. in order to be considered present for the full day. Students arriving after 11:30 a.m. will be considered absent for one-half day.

All absences will be treated as unlawful until a written excuse explaining the reason(s) for absence is received by the office.

WHAT IS EXCUSED??

- 1. Personal illness
- 2. Death in the family
- 3. Serious family illness
- 4. Educational and/or scholastic trip experiences <u>pre-approved</u> by the Principal.

**Ifexcuse is notsubmitted within 3 days it will be considered unlawful

PA ATTENDANCE LAW

State law requires, a child must comply with compulsory attendance requirements from age 6 to age 18. Specifically, a child who has attained the age of 6 on or before September 1 must enroll and attend school or begin a home school program that year. Additionally, any student less than 18 years of age must comply with compulsory school age requirements. The term "compulsory attendance" refers to the mandate that all children of compulsory school age having a legal residence in PA must attend a day school in which the subjects and activities are set by the standards of the State Board of Education.
