

She is working toward this goal by saving a significant portion of her salary and by being very frugal with her expenses. She has attended home ownership classes offered by H.O.M.E DuPage in order to obtain the certificate needed to apply for a home purchase grant.

We have discussed various housing options to identify what is available to her. She is very appreciative for the opportunity to be in the Bridge program and she has said that the journey has taught her a lot about how she wants her life to go as she moves forward.

Help Our Neighborhood Pantry

We've heard from some Warrenville folks already, asking how they can help the pantry at a moment when a lot of increased traffic is expected there. Items that are always needed, which people can drop off at the food pantry on Mondays and Thursdays between 2:30 and 5:00 pm:

Canned corn

Canned fruit (any variety)

Rice: 1 lb or 2 lb bags

Canned tuna or canned chicken

Kraft macaroni & cheese

To receive food, come for "in person" shopping at the pantry on **Sundays 1:00-3:00pm and Tuesdays 11:00am-1:00pm**. For those who cannot come in person or prefer not to, we also offer an order ahead program where they can pre-order online (go to <u>orderahead.org</u> and click on the IPC site) and then drive thru and pick up the order on Thursdays from 5:00pm-6:30pm.

Our Neighborhood Pantry serves all of Warrenville.

- + Have you ever built a tower out of blocks?
- + Did your tower last a long time, or did something break it apart?
- + How did you feel when it fell down? Did you try to build it again?

Tie it to the Gospel

- In today's scripture story, Jesus and his disciples are in Jerusalem where the Temple was located. The disciples are excited about seeing the Temple.
- But even though the Temple was much prettier AND better built than our little towers,
 Jesus tells the disciples in today's story that it was going to fall over.
- This must have sounded pretty scary to the disciples because when we are told things are going to be gone much sooner than we think they should last (like buildings), then that can make us feel unsure and afraid.

Our Mission:

- But what Jesus then teaches the disciples is that even though things like our little tower and big buildings like the Temple do not last forever...
- ...God DOES last forever.
- Which means when things are falling down or falling apart, God is and always will be with us.
- One of the ways that Jesus tells the disciples how God is always with us is by giving us words to share with others as well as wisdom about how to respond in the moment.
- Even in really scary situations when it feels like everything is falling apart, in today's story,
 Jesus reminds his disciples (and us) that God is with us.
- And, because God is with us in those scary moments, then God can help us know what to do and how to respond.



Our diocese will soon take up the national collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). 
