



Looking for some fun on a dreary winter day?





# Tie it to the Gospel

- In the Gospel, John the Baptist is telling the people to "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."
- John the Baptist is wary of the Pharisees and Sadducees (leaders of the time) coming to be baptized because he did not think that they had truly repented.
- John the Baptist is looking for the people and leaders to have a change of heart in order to be worthy of baptism - they need to truly repent.




