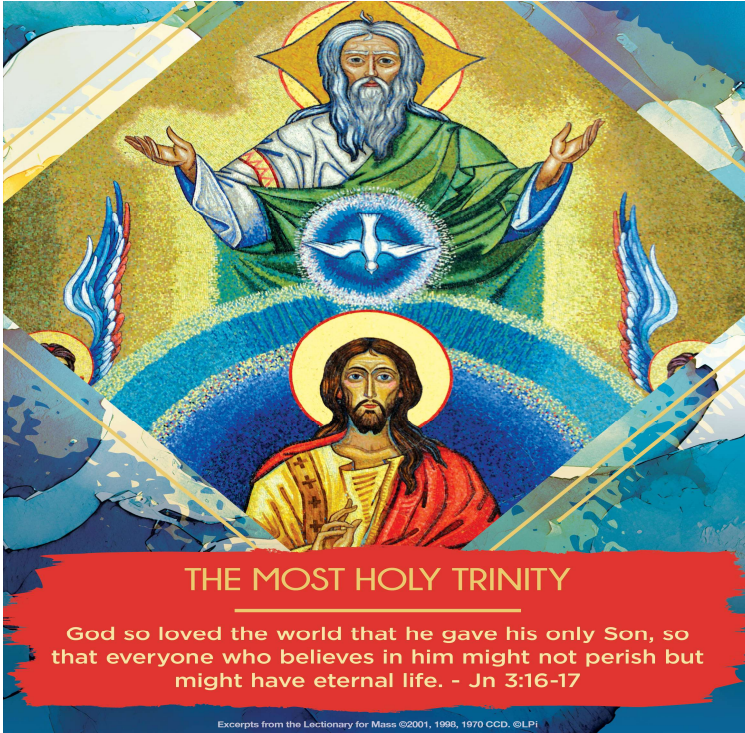

Our Mission:

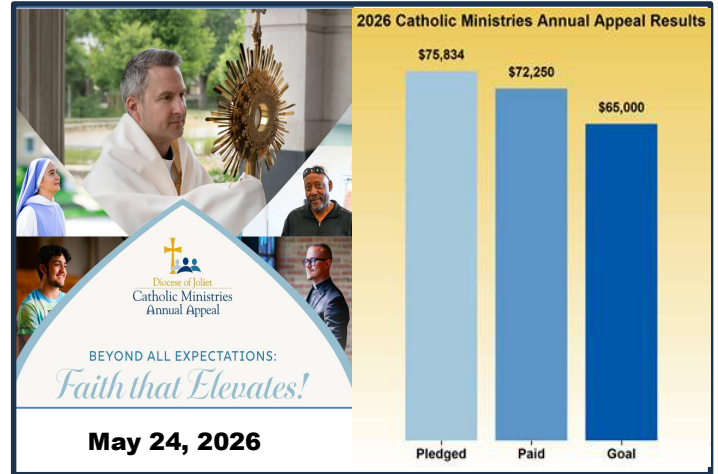
- We hear the readings each week, but we need to challenge ourselves to really listen to God's message.

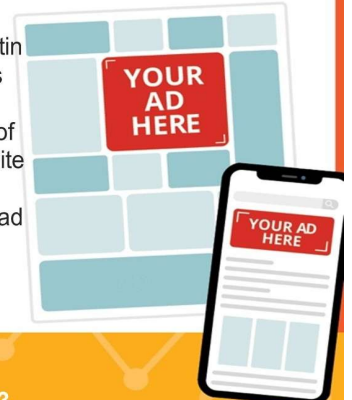
