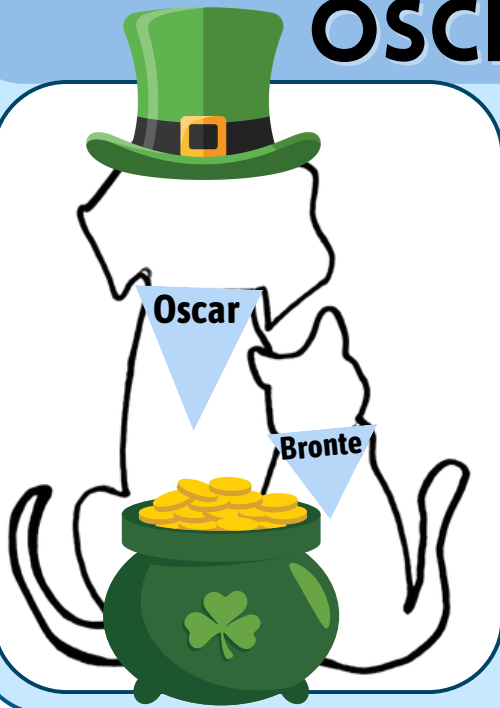

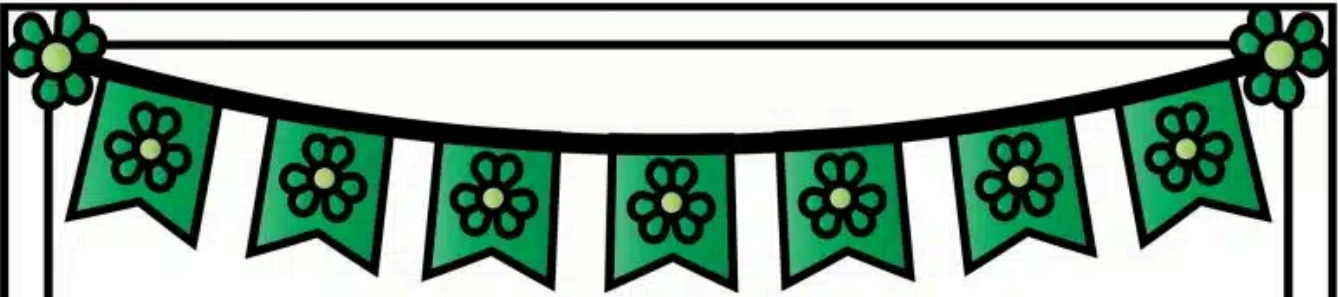
## *Resident Guide Recap:* **Elevator Safety**

OSCR's elevator doors are set to a slow speed to suit our clients, allowing everyone to safely enter and exit the elevators at their own pace. When the doors are closing, do not use your hand, arm, walker or other object to hold the door open. Only the OPEN button can keep the doors open for a short while longer. If the buzzer is sounding, you must keep clear of the doors as they will close regardless of pressing the OPEN button.

Please note that only 2 walkers are permitted in the elevator at a time.

Make sure everyone is off before you enter the elevator. Plan ahead for your elevator use for daily activities. Meal times are the busiest elevator times.

If you are in the elevator and the doors will not open or it is malfunctioning, press the telephone button on the selection panel; someone will assist you.
