Everyday Boldness
Daily Faithfulness - 1 Peter 4

- 1. What does Everyday Boldness look like?** Paint a picture. How would you describe it to others? Give an illustration or example to your Journey Group.
- 2. Standing in Contrast.** Josiah talked about the “Difference” of the Christian life, in itself, as being BOLD. Why is contrast so BOLD? Why does it appear so strong and in opposition with the beliefs and values of our culture and society?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 4:1-19. Read it again.** What is Peter driving at in this part of his letter? What is the overall encouragement and message he’s getting across to the suffering Church he’s writing to? How does this relate to daily faithfulness in the life of a Christian?
- 4. Suffering in the Flesh.** One of Peter’s major concerns in this passage is encouraging the Church that suffering in the flesh is worth it, as we are following God’s will; we are called to suffer in doing good, not evil. However... Faithfulness does not always feel good. Faithfulness is not always respected. What are ways that help us to fight the battle against the flesh? What are some disciplines or habits that you have that help you “arm yourself” so that you can stand in the Spirit instead of fall in the flesh?
- 5. Bearing The Name.** Have you had situations arise in your life where bearing the name of Christ or “Christian” has caused difficulty? Have you ever been rejected or hated because you believe in what the Bible teaches about truth or Christ? How about more generally in culture and society: how do we see God’s Word—His values, His teachings, His ways—be undermined or even blasphemed? Talk about this as a group.
- 6. Read 1 Peter 4:19.** This passage lands in a beautiful place, reminding the Church that they are entrusting their souls to the One who is worthy of being trusted: their Creator—God, Jesus Christ. How have you seen God be faithful in your life? How has He used His Word to keep you upright? How has He used others to shield you or battle alongside you? How are you relying upon His faithfulness today—that you may live faithfully for Him?
