## What is the answer to Sin?

- = "to agree with God" that what we did was wrong and repent.
- What happens when we confess? (1) Our sins are forgiven. (2) We are cleansed. (3) Our fellowship with God is restored.

### We have an (Jesus Christ).

- Advocate = "Someone who supports or defends us"
- Same term (Gk. paraclete) used for the
- Court terminology = Satan is the prosecuting attorney, but Jesus is our defense attornev.
- "propitiation" has two main ideas: (1) Advocacy. (2) Cleansing.
