3	: (Acts 28:30-31)
-	Paul kept going for years under house arrest. O He continued to witness, teach, etc. O He wrote Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon during this time. O He was ready to die. Philippians 1:20-21
-	Paul's case was likely and he was set free. O He likely went on a fourth missionary journey. O He also wrote the letters of I and II Timothy and Titus. O He was eventually arrested and brought back to Rome.
-	Tradition teaches that Paul was outside Rome on the Ostian Way [AD 67/68].
-	Are we willing to be like Paul?
-	The Book of Acts ends The story of the Unstoppable Church is ongoing, and we are part of that story. O We are part of that Legacy! O Hebrews 12:1-2
