Declaration of Compliance with Competition Law

The Associação de Armadores da Marinha de Comércio (AAMC) is firmly committed to maintaining a fair, transparent and competitive environment in the maritime transport sector.

In this regard, full compliance with all applicable national and European competition law rules constitutes a fundamental principle of AAMC.

In carrying out its functions, namely in representing and defending the interests of its member companies and promoting cooperation among them, AAMC ensures that all its activities, including meetings of the General Assembly, the Board of Directors, the Supervisory Board, as well as any committees, working groups or forums, are conducted in strict compliance with the applicable competition rules.

Declarations of Interest

AAMC is committed to best practices in associative governance and to high standards of integrity, transparency and accountability.

Within this framework, members of the Association's governing bodies, General Assembly, Board of Directors and Supervisory Board, must perform their duties independently, in the best interest of the Association and its statutory purposes, and must neither be, nor appear to be, unduly influenced by external interests.

Members must identify, declare and transparently manage any situations liable to constitute conflicts of interest, whether real, potential or apparent.

To this end, whenever applicable, members of the governing bodies must declare any relevant interests that may interfere with their impartiality, namely in matters included on meeting agendas, and must refrain from participating in the respective deliberations where appropriate.

This principle is essential to ensure the proper functioning of the Association's bodies and the confidence of its members in the performance of their duties, in accordance with statutory obligations and the general principles of good governance.



Privacy and Personal Data Protection Policy

AAMC complies with all applicable legal provisions regarding the protection of personal data, namely the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) and applicable national legislation, including Law no. 58/2019 of 8 August.

The Association has a Privacy and Personal Data Protection Policy, approved on 8 April 2024 and published on its website at <https://www.aamc.pt/>, which sets out the terms under which it processes personal data, as well as the rights of the respective data subjects.

Within the scope of its activities, AAMC collects and processes personal data of members, governing body members, institutional partners, suppliers, employees and other stakeholders, exclusively for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes related to the pursuit of its statutory objectives, including representation, cooperation and information sharing in the maritime transport sector.

AAMC ensures that the processing of personal data is carried out in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, data minimisation, accuracy, storage limitation, integrity and confidentiality, also ensuring the adoption of appropriate technical and organisational measures for data protection.
