

Saint John Chrysostom was know as Golden Mouthed because he was a great speaker. He talked to people about Jesus.




Can you find the bees?



The candles in the church are made from beeswax. How many candles are in your church?




Saint Padre Pio

When people went to confession with him, he KNEW when they were forgetting something. He would help them remember so they learned from all of their sins.








Have you ever seen the monstrance in your church?

Saint Vincent de Paul spent his life helping poor people. He brought toys and food to poor children and helped to bring them closer to God.





current Pope?



Gregorian Chant is music named after Saint Gregory. The squares tell people what notes to sing.


The words are in Latin. It means,
