The candles in the church are made from beeswax. How many candles are in your church?

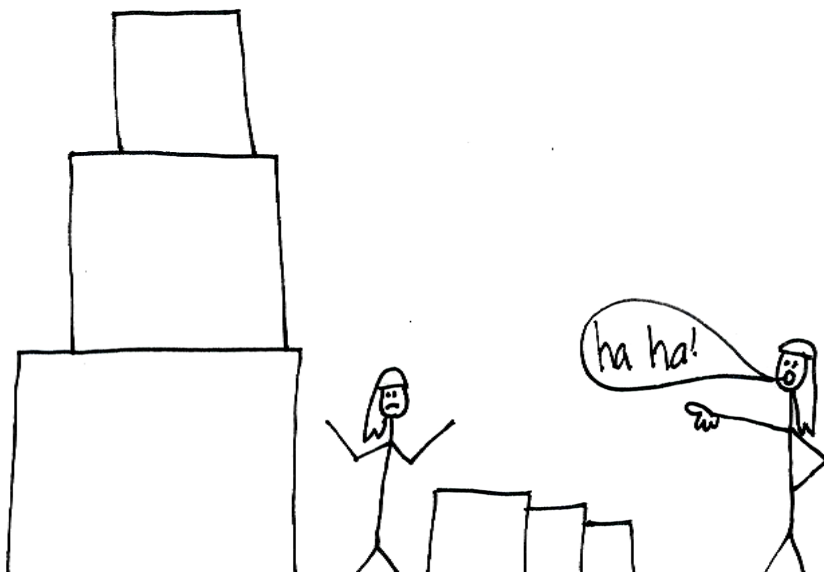

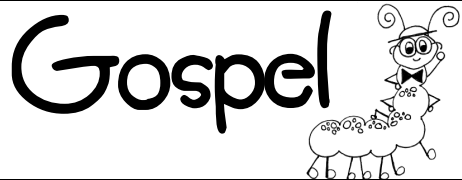


Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple.

This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.

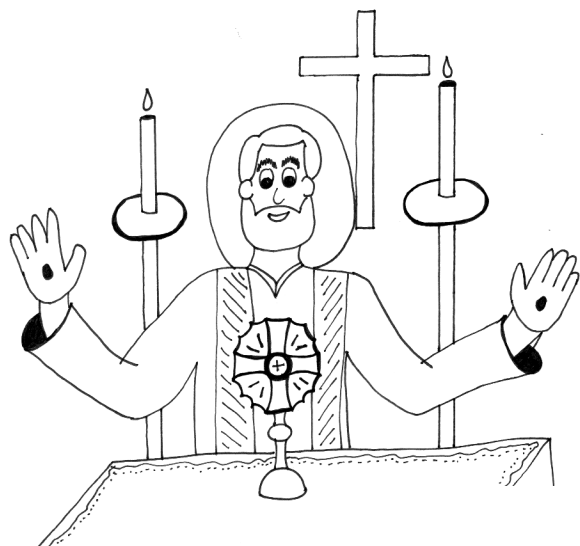


When a king is still far away, he will send a group of soldiers to ask for peace.

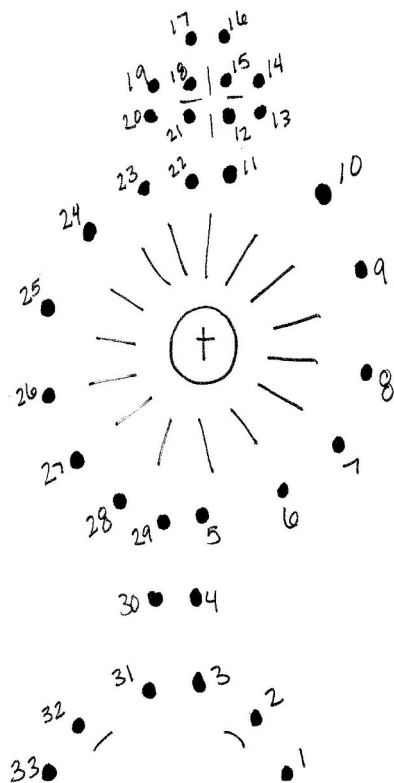
Saint Padre Pio

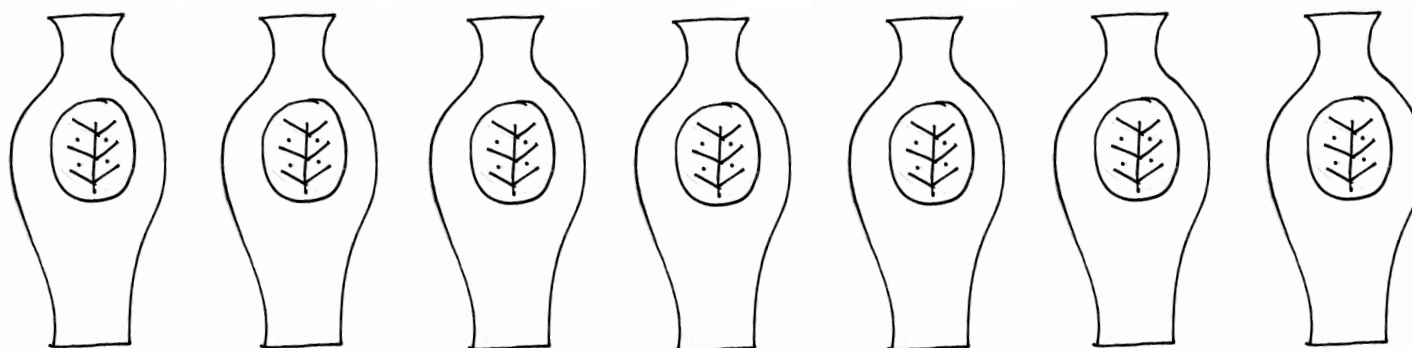


During Mass, the whole church celebrates together. Your participation in Mass is connected to everyone else that is praying in Heaven and Earth.
