The Catholic Kids Bulletins downloads contain bulletins for all Sunday Masses and Holy Days of Obligation for diocese in the United States. If you live in an area with a Holy Day of Obligation that isn't included, please email me at catholickidsbulletin@outlook.com and I'll try to make it available in future downloads.

Ascension is listed without a date because most diocese move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few diocese in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on the Thursday or Sunday.

Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

During Lent, there are Sundays (3rd, 4th, and 5th) in which churches can use either the Year C readings or the Year A Scrutinies. Both are included and labeled on the lower left hand corner.






In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us a new commandment, or rule. He said, "Love one another as I have loved you."

Saint Michael the Archangel told Saint Joan of Arc to lead the French army. Joan was only 16, but she followed God's message and won!





Gospel


Jesus talked with His disciples and told them about the Holy Spirit.


The Holy Spirit gives us many gifts, such as wisdom,
