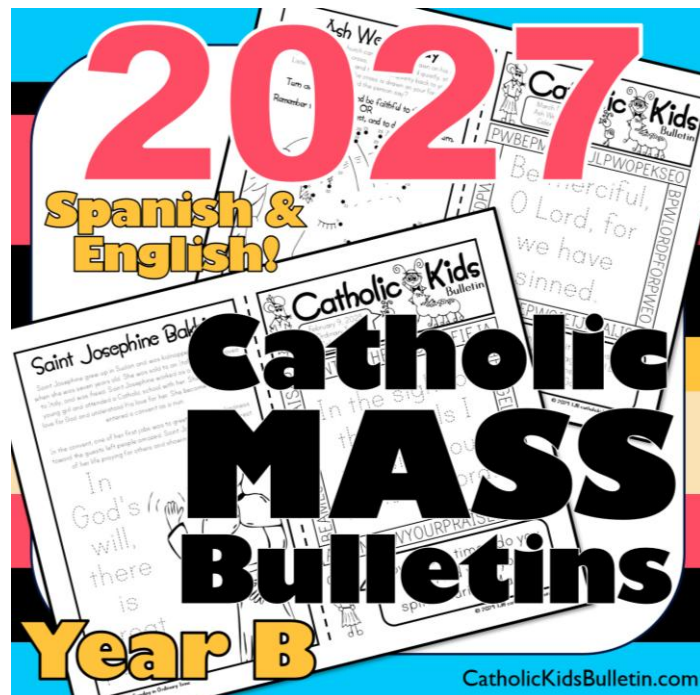

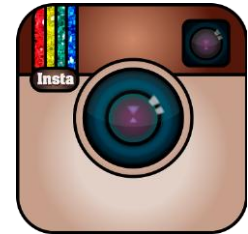

The Catholic Kids Bulletin downloads include bulletins for **all Sunday Masses and Holy Days of Obligation in U.S. dioceses**. **The Ascension** is listed without a date because most dioceses celebrate it on Sunday, while some still celebrate it on Thursday. This allows you to use the bulletin for either celebration.

**Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday** are also included, even though they aren't Holy Days of Obligation.

During Lent, the **3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays** may use either the regular Year B readings or the Year B Scrutinies. Both versions are included and labeled in the lower-left corner.

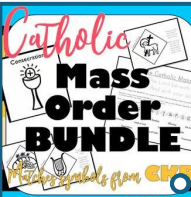

Saint John Chrysostom was known as "Golden Mouthed" because he was a great speaker. He talked to people about Jesus.

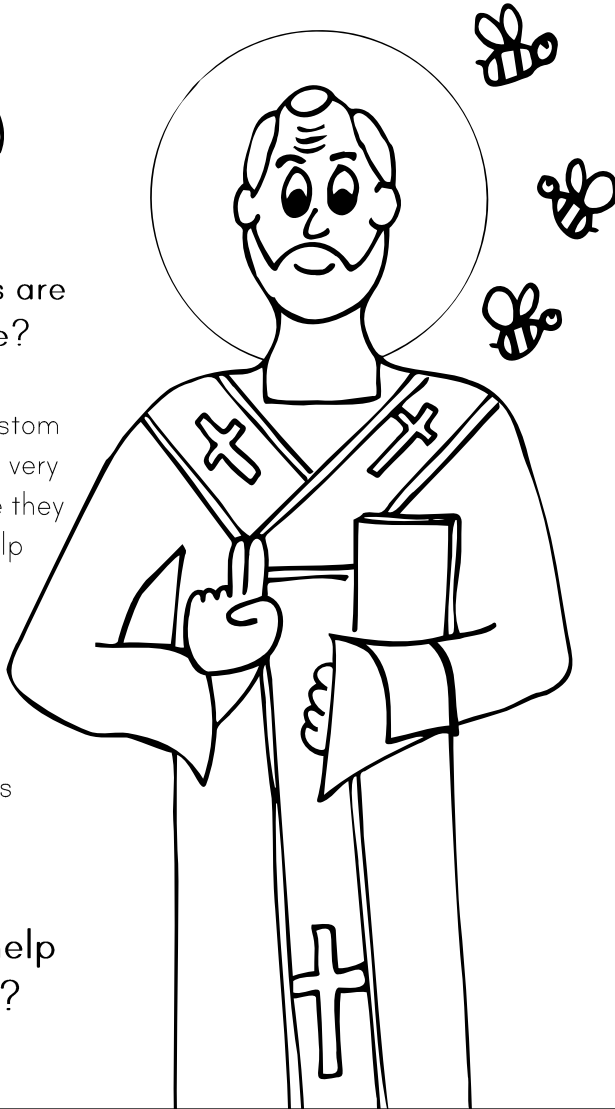


How many bees are in this picture?

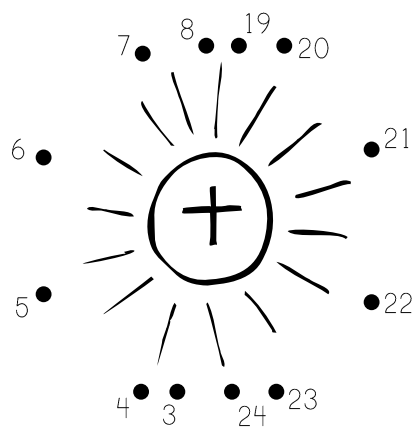
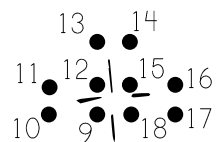


Jesus is teaching the disciples about the church. The church isn't just the building—it's all the people that worship God.

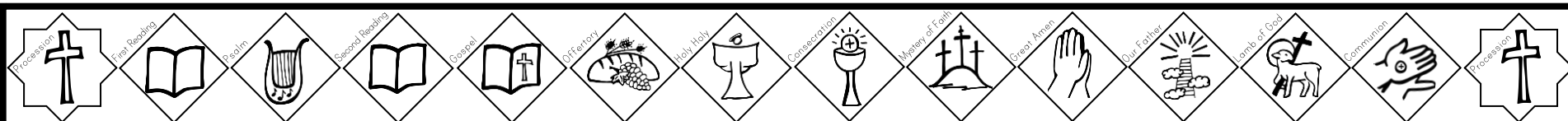

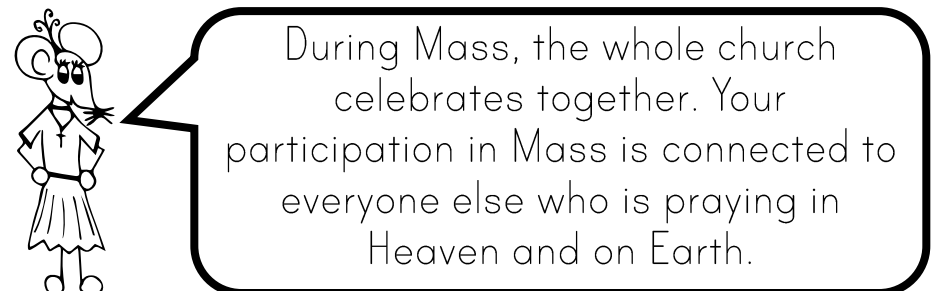
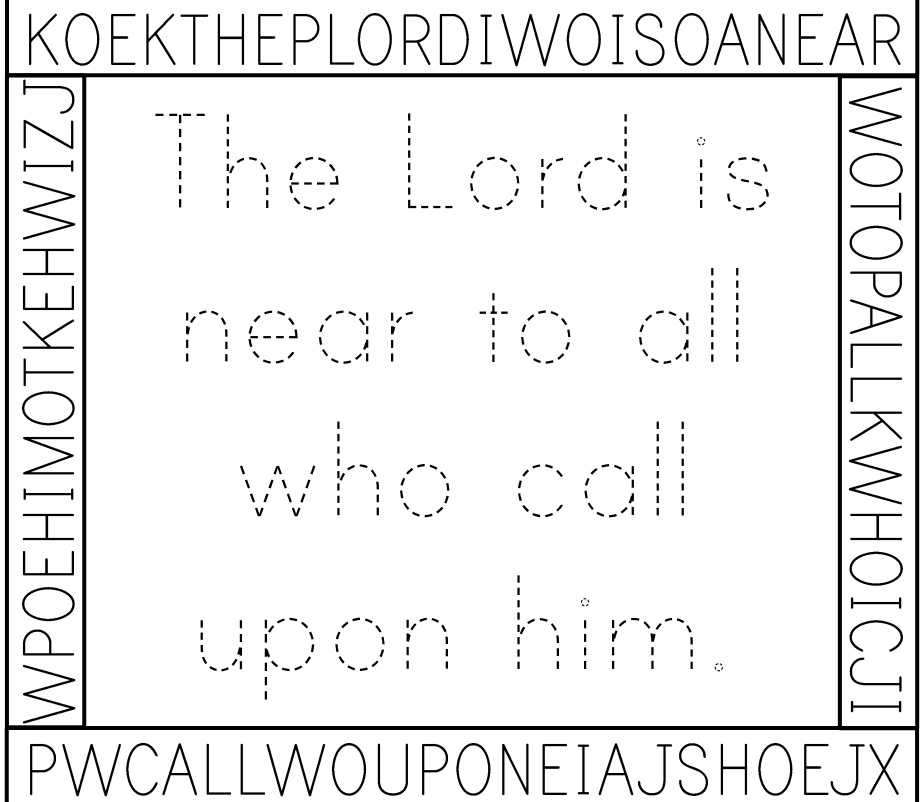

# Saint Vincent de Paul

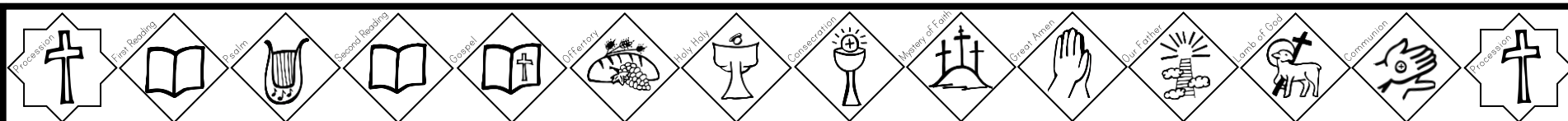
Saint Vincent de Paul spent his life helping poor people. He brought toys and food to children in need and helped to bring them closer to God.



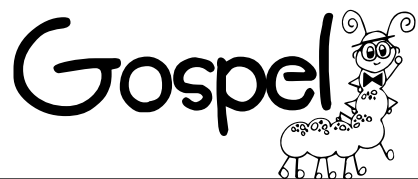
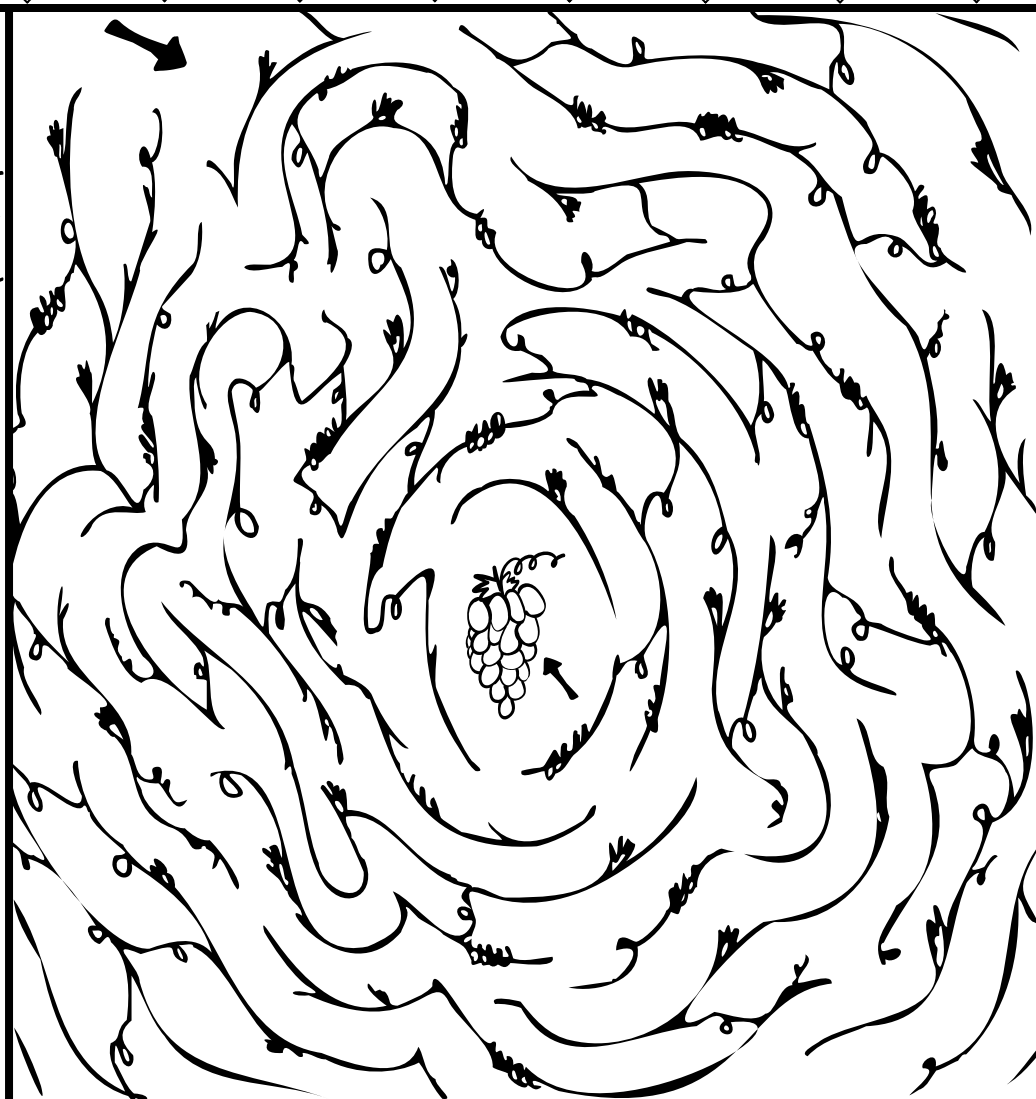
Year A: Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

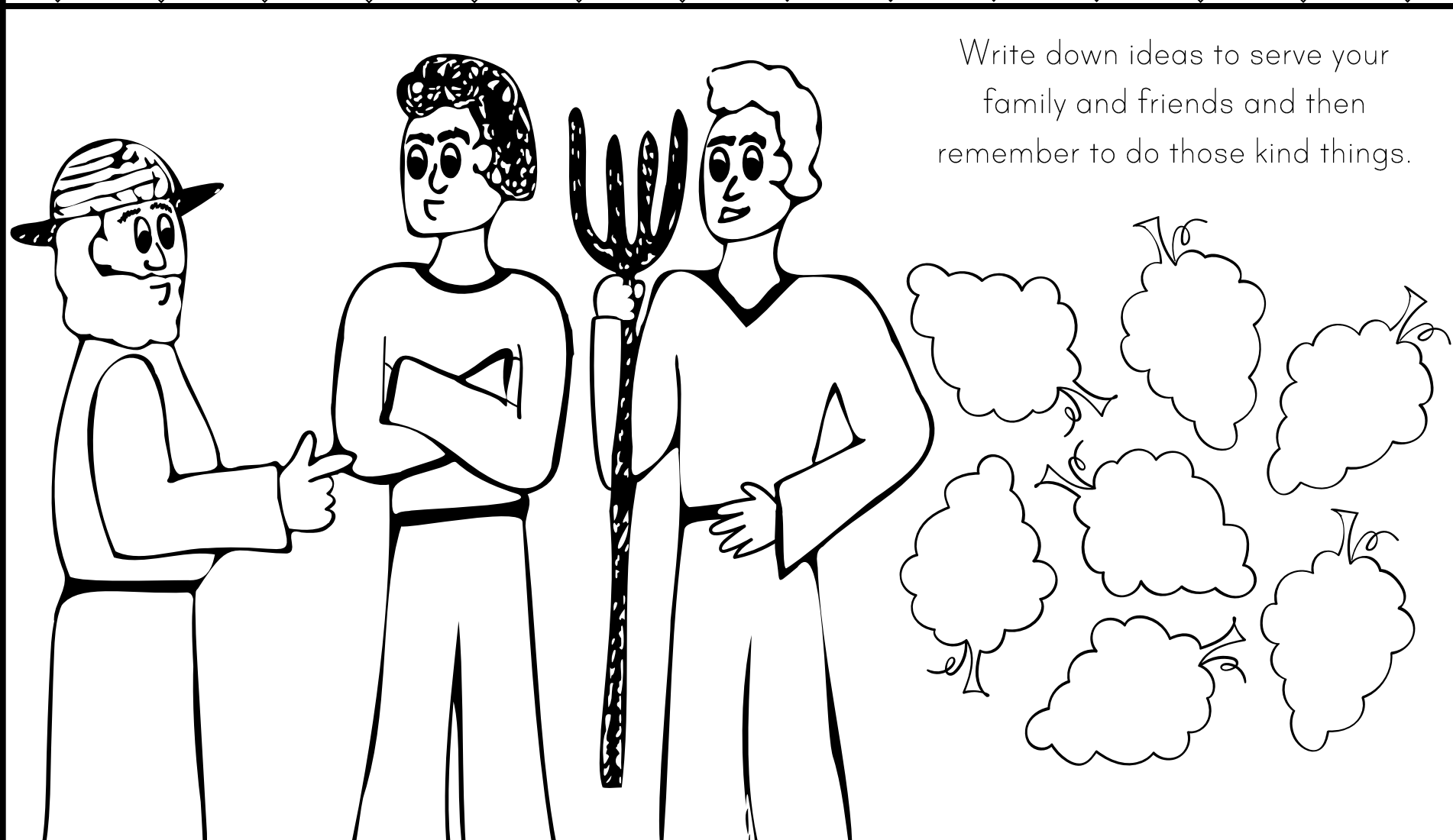
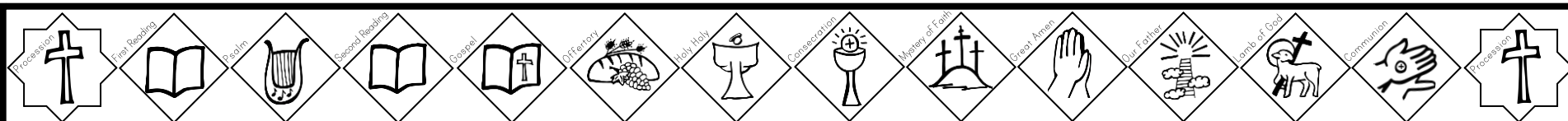

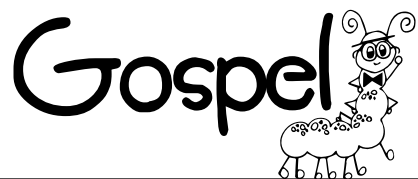
