Announcer

Sit in the bleachers with a front-row view! Your job is to call out events and heats for swimmers behind the blocks and at the ready bench. Clear communication helps keep the meet running smoothly.

Runner

Stationed near the timer console with another front-row seat. If officials need times from timers, you quickly collect and deliver what's required. You help keep the meet on schedule.

Awards

Apply event stickers to ribbons and organize them by team. You may take breaks to watch your swimmer's races—an easy job that helps make the meet special for the kids.

Ready Bench

One of the most crucial jobs for a smooth meet! You'll help line up swimmers by event, heat, and lane and guide them to the correct chairs. Experienced parents will mentor you, and you'll be a pro after a few minutes.

Hospitality

Enjoy the air-conditioned hospitality room! You'll help pass out water, restock snacks, and keep the area tidy. You can step out to watch your swimmer race.

Timers

The meet cannot run without timers. This job gives you a front-row seat and a little splash! It's easy and fun, with a timer meeting beforehand to answer any questions. If you are a second-shift timer, please ensure you replace a Surge timer before leaving.
