In New Zealand lamb finishing systems, consistent growth and timely finishing are key to maximising farm profitability. Lamb conditioning pellets provide a balanced, high-energy feed designed to support lambs during key periods when pasture quality or intake alone may not meet nutritional demands.

Feeding a well-formulated pellet helps lambs reach target weights sooner, maintain condition, and produce better carcasses.

## Smart Choice for Your Lambs

Lamb conditioning pellets are a practical, high-value tool to unlock genetic potential, optimise finishing, and enhance profitability.

### Why Feed Lamb Conditioning Pellets?

In NZ's seasonal pastures, lambs often need a nutritional boost post-weaning to maintain growth through summer/autumn dips or to hit premium market specs quickly.

Advanced Feed's Lamb Conditioning Pellets provide consistent, balanced nutrition to maintain lamb growth and finishing performance when pasture alone cannot meet nutritional demands.

### Key Benefits

#### Faster Finishing

High-energy pellets support rapid weight gain, helping lambs reach market weight earlier and reducing the time lambs remain on farm.

#### Maintain Growth When Pasture Drops

During dry periods, late summer, autumn, or winter, pasture energy and protein levels can decline. Pellets help maintain consistent growth rates.

#### Improved Carcass Quality

Balanced nutrition helps lambs achieve better fat cover and more even carcasses, improving processor acceptance and market returns.

#### Efficient Feed Conversion

Pelleted feeds are designed for high digestibility, meaning lambs convert feed into liveweight gain efficiently.

#### Consistent Nutrition

Unlike pasture which varies daily, pellets provide reliable energy, protein, vitamins and minerals to support lamb performance.

### Lamb Conditioning Pellets

#### TYPICAL ANALYSIS (Dry matter basis):

Dry Matter	87.4%
Crude Protein	17.3%
M.E.	12.3 MJME/kg
NDF	15.5%

#### Recommended Feeding Rates

- Finishing lambs: 200 – 500 g/head/day
- High growth finishing systems: up to 700 g/head/day depending on pasture availability

Introduce pellets gradually over 5–7 days.

Feed alongside adequate pasture, hay, or forage.

Always ensure clean fresh water is available.

**INGREDIENTS SELECTED FROM:** Wheat, Barley, Lime, Soya meal, Soya hulls, Salt, Sodium bentonite, Vitamins & Minerals, Sweetener.

**CONTRAINDICATIONS:** Introduce pellets gradually to avoid digestive upset or rumen acidosis.

Do not feed excessive quantities without access to adequate fibre (pasture, hay or silage).

Care should be taken when feeding sheep not previously exposed to grain-based feeds.

Not intended for feeding to horses or other equids.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place protected from moisture and vermin.

Use within a reasonable time after opening to maintain freshness and feed quality.
