Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and visitation or disposition. 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Disbursements

Disbursements are third-party costs that we may arrange or pay on your behalf. These amounts are payable when the contract is signed. The following are common examples of disbursements that may apply, depending on the services selected.

Coroner's fee – this fee is charged by the coroner for issuing the certificate required for cremation. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium / musicians – this amount is paid to clergy, celebrants, musicians or other service participants. In some cases, the amount is set by the provider; in others, it is determined by the family.

Newspaper, radio or other media notices – these charges apply to death notices or announcements placed in newspapers, on radio, or through other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this fee is charged by the local municipality to register the death. The amount is set by the municipality and may vary.

Flowers – we can assist with ordering floral arrangements from the florist of your choice. Flower costs are charged at the florist's rate.

Cemetery services – we can arrange payment for cemetery charges on your behalf. These charges are set by the cemetery and may include interment, cremation, or related cemetery fees. Costs vary by cemetery and by the services selected.

Payment for At-Need Services

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. We accept payment by cash, cheque or e-transfer. Payment plans may be available to accommodate most budgets; financing charges apply. After the allotted payment period, interest will be charged at 2% per month, equivalent to 24% per annum (APR). We do not accept credit cards or debit cards due to bank processing fees. E-transfer payments may be sent to wkfh@rogers.com.

For prepaid services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

Funding Options

For your convenience, two funding options are available when prepaying for services or supplies. Prepaid funds are used to pay for the selected services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay funds directly to us, and we will place them in trust. The funds will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled, when the services and supplies are delivered, or until the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract, with the proceeds used to pay for the selected services or supplies when they are delivered or if the contract is cancelled.
