Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium/ Musicians – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may very.

Catering services - Typically done by church groups, the fees are based off of a donation towards the church group. This donation is at cost and the funeral home does not receive any compensation. Other services are available are available at the discretion of the family.

Flowers – we are glad to assist you with flower selection from the florist of your choice

Cemetery Services – we will provide payment for cemetery charges. These charges are at the cost of the cemetery. In most rural cemeteries there is an additional fee of \$ 175.00 when a vault has been selected and \$ 550.00 when a vault is not selected for cemetery grass and device.

Payment, financing and funding

Payment of at need services

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, or cheque, we do not accept credit card or debit card as banks fees are too high.
