Mayor Dave Hodgson has recently announced that he will allocate an extra £1m to road resurfacing and an extra £1m for pavement resurfacing this year. This is in addition to the increase that was already included as part of this year's council budget.

Dave Hodgson said, "I have always made looking after our local environment a top priority and that includes the roads and pavements we use day in day out. This is important for pedestrians as well as cyclists and motorists. I hear time and again how this is important to residents and I want to make sure we do everything we can despite government funding cuts to continue to improve our local roads and footways."

Wendy Rider & Charles Roydon have backed Mayor Dave Hodgson's boost to the resurfacing and renewal programme.

Charles said, "It has always been one of our top priorities to get the state of local roads and pavements improved.
