

Cost of Living Crisis: Survey shows residents are already having to make difficult choices



Dave Hodgson and the local Liberal Democrats are very concerned about the impact the cost of living crisis is having on local residents. To help understand the range of issues faced by people we have launched a Cost of Living residents survey.

The first responses to the Cost of Living Survey are coming in and they show the difficulties many residents are already facing. Residents across the Borough have told us that they have already changed habits or routines to cope with the rising cost of living, including sitting in the dark, skipping meals and selling their vehicles which affects their ability to get to work. Bedford Borough Liberal Democrats are calling on the government to do more to help residents who are already struggling to cope.

Mayor Dave Hodgson said, "It's terrible to read how people are having to make such difficult choices. We need urgent action from the government to support our residents. All too often the government's response is too little and too late."

A428 to Cambridge Upgrade

A vital upgrade to improve hundreds of thousands of journeys between Bedford, Cambridge and beyond has been given the green light to proceed.

Planning permission has been given by the government for National Highways to begin work on the



A428 Black Cat to Caxton Gibbet improvements, which will tackle one of the region's most notorious congestion hotspots.

Plans will see the creation of a new 10-mile dual carriageway linking the A1 Black Cat roundabout in Bedfordshire to the A428 Caxton Gibbet roundabout in Cambridgeshire. Both existing roundabouts will be upgraded into modern, free-flowing junctions.

Dave Hodgson said, "It's great to see that we have passed another important milestone for the upgraded route. I know so many local residents support this project and look forward to the vital carriageway and junction upgrades. Together we are making the Borough a better place to live, work and visit."

Ashmead Road Crossing

Mayor's 10 Year Record of Renewable Energy Innovation



The Hydro Power
Facility on the River
Great Ouse has been
generating clean,
renewable energy for
Bedford Borough and
beyond for over 10
years. Since then the
Council has been
installing and
promoting new
innovative ways to

generate clean energy and reduce the Borough's carbon emissions.

The two Archimedean Screw Generators run independently and produce approximately 130,000 kWh of power each year. The energy is then exported to the National Grid for which the Council has received over £300,000.

Mayor Dave Hodgson said, "The screws have been a great success. They produce lots of energy that was previously being lost and they have a very low environmental impact. We must continue to find innovative solutions to the climate emergency and ensure a just transition to renewable energy sources."

Wendy Rider added, "Under Lib Dem leadership the Council has installed solar panels on many council-owned buildings and most recently, the Elstow Solar Farm has been fully energised and has started exporting low-carbon electricity to the National Grid."

Work Starts for Wixams Station



Dave Hodgson recently visited the site of the proposed **Wixams railway station** to observe the current works that are underway. Geotechnical surveys are ongoing and a programme for ecology works has commenced.

Dave Hodgson said, "It was great to see that enabling work has commenced as we work towards the station opening in 2024."


Putnoe walk in centre

closure has been stopped for now.




