## CLASSES OFFERED

18 months (2 days)	Tuesday/Thursday	\$190/month
2K (3 days)	Monday, Wednesday, & Friday	\$225/month
2K (5 days)	Monday - Friday	\$300/month
3K (3 days)	Monday, Wednesday, & Friday	\$225/month
3K (5 days)	Monday - Friday	\$300/month
4K (5 days)	Monday - Friday	\$300/month

\*\*Classes are assigned based on availability and need. Ages may be combined based on enrollment.\*\*

## OVERVIEW OF KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

- A **non-refundable \$150 Registration Fee** is due with your registration form. Should circumstances keep your child from attending after registration fees are paid, please inform the Director as soon as possible so those on the waiting list may be contacted about open spots.
- A one-time **\$100 Supply Fee** is due with August tuition.
- Kindergarten **begins August 13, 2026 and ends May 14, 2027**. We follow the school calendar as set by Laurens District 55 School for determination of holidays and staff work days. FBCK does not have school on district Half Days.
- Our school days begins with **drop-off from 8:15am - 8:30am. Pick-up is from 12:15pm - 12:30pm**.
- **Procare** is our online program to manage registration, student information, parent communication, tuition and all other payments.
- **Tuition** is due on the first of each month through your Procare Account. A \$10 late fee is applied after the 10th of the month. If tuition is not paid by the 15th of the month, the late fee increases to \$25. All payments must be paid online through your Procare Account. **We will not accept check or cash payments.**
- If you are **enrolling more than one child**, the younger child receives a **15% tuition discount**.
- Tuition is tax deductible.

# CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

## **2K OVERVIEW**

Our two-year-olds may attend three or five days a week. Each two-year-old class has space for 10 children and is taught by a teacher and an assistant. Sharing and playing with others while learning to communicate personal needs and wants are promoted and practiced in these classes. In addition to developing social skills, pre-reading and pre-math skills are taught through a variety of hands-on activities, materials, and centers. Their schedule is flexible and includes circle/story time, indoor and outdoor play, music time, snack, and simple art projects and manipulatives. We gladly work with parents as students become potty trained. Curriculum is based on themes such as family, animals, holidays and seasons to grow students vocabulary and knowledge of the world around them.

## **3K OVERVIEW**

Three-year-olds may attend three or five days a week. Each three-year-old class has space for 12 children and is taught by a teacher and an assistant. These children are more independent and ready to learn. Development of social skills continues in this class as students experience opportunities to play, share, listen, follow directions and help others. Pre-reading and pre-math skills are taught and reinforced through a variety of hands-on materials and activities during circle time, center time and small group lessons. Curriculum focuses on a letter or theme each week and all classroom activities revolve around that letter or theme for the week. Fine motor skills (such as holding a crayon or pencil) and gross motor skills (like jumping and skipping) are also taught and practiced in an encouraging environment. Songs, movement, and art are also a part of the daily routine.

## **4K OVERVIEW**

Four-year-olds attend five days a week to best prepare them for 5K. This class has space for 12 children and is taught by a teacher and an assistant. All four year olds are required to be potty trained. 4K goals focus on nurturing and developing the whole child so that students are mentally, physically, socially and emotionally ready for 5K. Pre-reading skills and pre-math concepts are emphasized during circle time, centers, and small group lessons. Curriculum focuses on a letter or theme of the week/month and classroom activities revolve around that letter or theme for the week/month. All activities encourage student engagement and ownership of their learning. All components of this classroom environment intentionally provide opportunities that foster students' self esteem, confidence, and independence as he or she approaches 5K.

## WEEKLY ACTIVITIES

### **CHAPEL**

Bible lessons, that relate to everyday life, are led by the ministerial staff to grow children's knowledge of God and His love for them.

### **MUSIC**

Children learn about rhythm, beat, instruments and music basics through a variety of songs and instrument play.

### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

Children like to move and need to move! The physical education class will focus on large motor skills, balance and coordination. Again, every child develops at his own pace and no one is forced to do something they are not ready to do. FUN is the key in this class!
