Brothers and sisters: Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 

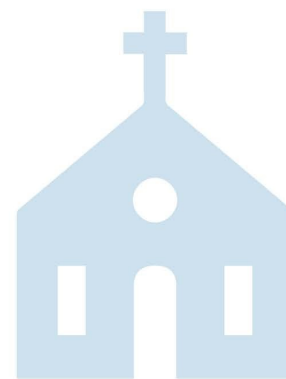

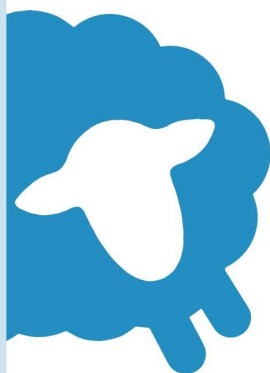
