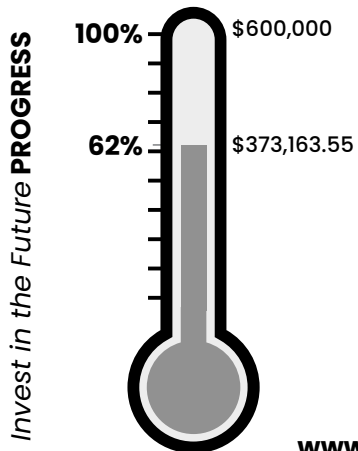

For group discussion the week of March 29

**This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!**

1. Think about a time when something you were really looking forward to didn't turn out the way you expected — good or bad. What happened, and how did you respond?
2. This week's message was *Palm Sunday — Taking a Closer Look*. Let's read Luke 19:28–40. Was there a part of the message or this passage that stood out to you, or something you felt God highlighting?
3. Let's also look at Matthew 21:8–11. The crowds are celebrating Jesus as He enters Jerusalem. What do you notice about what the people are saying and doing — and what they seem to expect from Jesus?
4. Now let's read Zechariah 9:9. This prophecy describes the kind of king Jesus would be. What does this show us about God's heart and the kind of Savior He chose to send, compared to what people were expecting?
5. The people wanted a conquering king, but Jesus came as a humble Savior. Where in your life have you found yourself wanting God to show up a certain way — but He didn't meet that expectation? If you're comfortable sharing, how did that affect your trust in Him?
6. As we head into this week leading up to Easter, what's one practical way you can choose to trust Jesus for who He really is — not just who you want Him to be? Is there a specific situation where you can surrender your expectations and invite Him to lead?
7. As we wrap up, how can we pray for you this week? Is there anything you're carrying — or an area where you're asking God to help you trust Him more?
