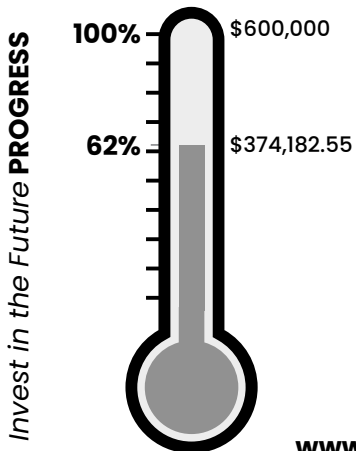

# TCC LIFE groups

For group discussion the week of April 5

**This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!**

1. Think about a time when you were really hoping for something... and it didn't turn out the way you expected. How did that affect you?
2. This week's Easter message was *The Resurrection of Hope*. Let's read Luke 24:1-9. Was there a moment or part of the message that really stood out to you or felt like God was getting your attention?
3. Let's read Luke 24:13-21. As you picture these two disciples walking along, what stands out to you about their emotional state or what they're going through?
4. Let's read Romans 5:1-5. The word "hope" is mentioned three times in these verses. What do we learn about hope from these verses? Why is hope important?
5. The disciples went from feeling like their hope was completely gone... to experiencing a new kind of living hope. Where do you feel that tension in your own life right now — between discouragement and hope?
6. Can you think of someone who's hope is thin or lost? What is a way God might use you to bring that person light and hope? See Matthew 5:14-16.
7. As we wrap up, how can we be praying for you this week? Is there anything you're carrying right now where you need to experience God's hope?
