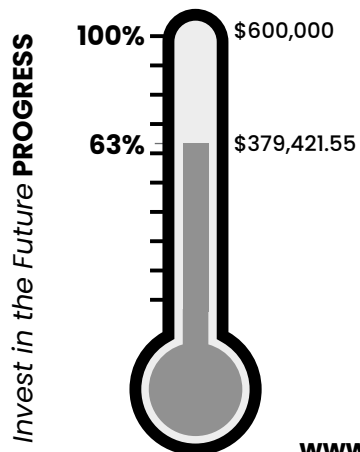

For group discussion the week of April 26

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

1. What's a time in your life when you felt like an unlikely choice for something — but you stepped into it anyway? What happened?
2. This week's message was *Pretty Bold for a Fisherman*. Let's read Acts 2:12–18. Was there a part of the message that really stood out to you or felt like God was trying to get your attention?
3. Let's read John 16:13 and Romans 8:14. What do you notice about how the Holy Spirit works in our lives? How do you see that playing out in Peter's transformation?
4. Let's read 1 Corinthians 1:27–29 and 1 Samuel 16:7. What does this show us about God's heart when it comes to who He uses and how He works?
5. Peter went from fear and failure to boldness through surrender. Where do you feel most tempted to hold back — fear, insecurity, feeling unqualified, or something else? How might Paul's reaction to his thorn in the flesh help us? See 2 Corinthians 12:9–10.
6. The message challenged us to notice where the Spirit might be nudging us to speak or act. What's one specific situation where you sense that nudge? What would it look like to take a simple, doable step in that direction?
7. As we wrap up, how can we pray for you this week? Is there anything you're carrying or anything related to this step of faith that you'd like support in?
