The two groups of religious leaders who stand in opposition to the early church: the Pharisees and the Sadducees.

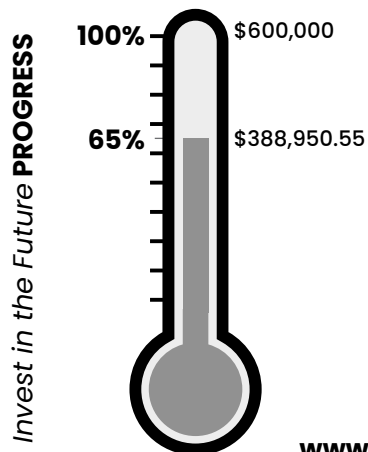

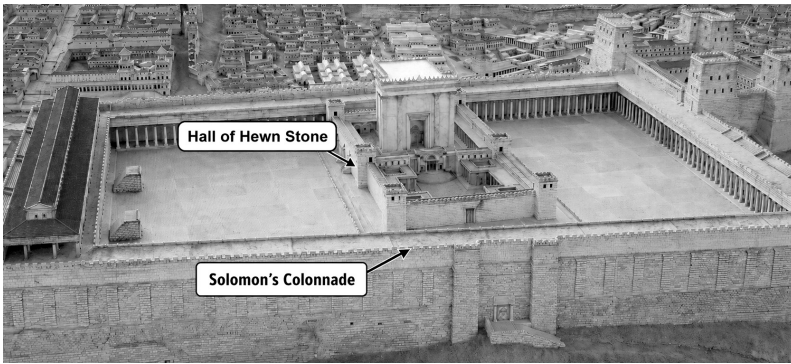

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TCC LIFE groups

For group discussion the week of May 24

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

1. Can you think of a time when you had to speak up about something that mattered to you? What made that difficult — or what gave you courage?
2. This week's message was called *Power Struggle*. Let's read Acts 4:8–20. Was there a part of the message or Scripture that stood out to you or that God drew your attention to? Why do you think that connected with you?
3. Peter stood before the Sanhedrin with unexpected courage, Let's read Acts 4:8 and Acts 1:8 to find out why. What do you notice about the connection between the Holy Spirit and Peter's courage? What stands out to you about the kind of power the Spirit gives?
4. The message pointed out the difference between protecting control and choosing to obey God. Let's read 2 Timothy 1:7–8. What does this passage say about God's heart and desire for His people when fear, pressure, and opposition arise?
5. Let's read John 3:1–2 and John 19:38–39. Nicodemus first came to Jesus secretly at night. Later, after Jesus' died, he publicly helped care for Jesus' body. What does his story show us about how faith and courage can sometimes grow over time? Are there places where you feel God inviting you to take a next step toward faith and boldness?
6. Let's read Colossians 4:2–6. What might it look like this week to be available to the Holy Spirit as a witness to Jesus? Is there a conversation, relationship, or an opportunity where you sense God inviting you to step in?
7. Share prayer requests.
