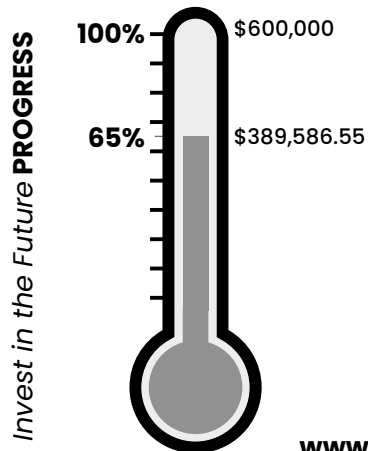

Spirit-Saturated Prayers

ACTS 4:23-31

They begin by remembering who God is: their Sovereign Lord.

Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the LORD and against His anointed, saying, "Let us break their chains and throw off their shackles." The One enthroned in Heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them.

PSALM 2:1-4 NIV

Worldly powers conspire and plot, but God sits on His throne and laughs at the futility of their efforts.

While we can only watch history unfold and wonder how it will all play out, God knows exactly how it will play out because He's working it out according to His will.

They don't pray for protection or provision. They pray for boldness to join Him in the redemptive work He's doing.

TCC LIFE groups

For group discussion the week of May 31

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

1. The message opened with the idea of wanting a “warp zone” to skip hard things in life. If you could skip a difficult or frustrating situation in life, what would it be, and why?
2. This week's message was *Spirit-Saturated Prayers*. Let's read Acts 4:23–31. Was there something that stood out to you or that God seemed to bring to your attention?
3. The disciples began their prayer by recognizing God's sovereignty before bringing their request. Let's read Psalm 46:1–11. What do you notice about the connection between trusting God's control and facing difficult situations?
4. The message emphasized that God is not absent when hardship comes, but often works through it. Let's read Romans 8:35–39. What does this passage show us about God's heart and His faithfulness when we face opposition, suffering, or uncertainty? How might this shape the way we think about trials as Followers of Jesus?
5. The disciples did not pray for escape or comfort — they prayed for boldness to join God in what He was doing. Let's read another example in 2 Timothy 1:7–8. Boldness often feels beyond us. Is there an area of your life where fear, insecurity, or uncertainty makes bold faith difficult?
6. The message challenges us to move from comfort-centered prayers to Spirit-saturated prayers. What would it look like for you to pray for boldness this week in a specific area of your life? What step could you take in that direction?
7. The disciples brought their fears and struggles to God and asked for courage. Where do you need God's strength right now? How can we pray for you?
