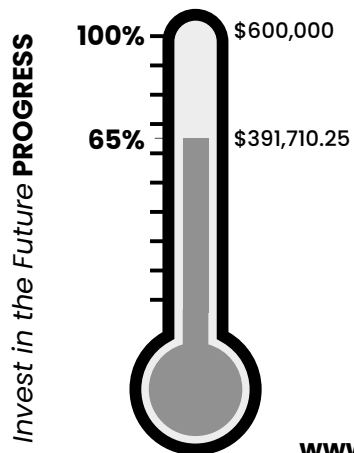

For group discussion the week of June 7

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

1. Think about someone who has had a positive influence on your life. What is one quality they demonstrated that helped shape who you are today?
2. Let's read Acts 4:31-37. Was there a part of Sunday's message that especially stood out to you, challenged you, or encouraged you?
3. Read Galatians 5:22-23. The message reminded us that being Spirit-filled is often seen through practical love, generosity, kindness, and unity. What does this say about how our efforts to follow the Holy Spirit impact community?
4. The story of Ananias and Sapphira reminds us that God desires authenticity rather than appearances. In Psalm 139:23-24, David asks God to search his heart for hidden agendas and motives. How might a practice like this help us keep our heart right?
5. One statement from the message was: "The fear that rules our hearts will shape the faithfulness of our lives." Read Proverbs 29:25. Are there areas where you find yourself seeking approval, managing perceptions, or worrying about what others think? What might it look like to trust God more in that situation?
6. The Holy Spirit forms our character, integrity, and courage to send us into mission. Which of those areas — generosity, honesty, courage, or witness — do you sense God wanting to grow in your life right now? What is one practical step you can take this week?
7. As you seek to walk with the Holy Spirit this week, where do you most need His help, strength, wisdom, or encouragement? How can we pray for you?
