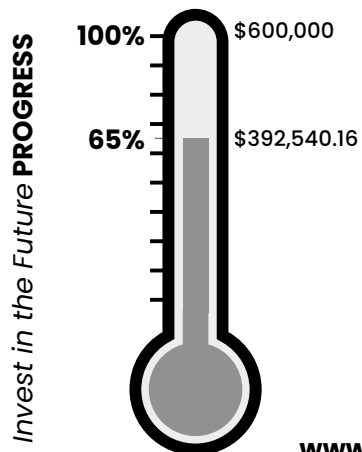

**This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!**

1. Can anyone give an example of something that started out exciting but became overwhelming as it grew?
2. Let's read Acts 6:1-7. Was there a part of this week's message that stood out to you or that you sensed God drawing your attention to?
3. In Exodus 18:17-23, we see Moses trying to do too much on his own. What similarities do you see between this situation and what the apostles faced in Acts 6? What can we learn from this?
4. Let's read Ephesians 4:11-13. According to Paul, what is the role of church leaders, and what is the role of God's people? What does this say about God's design for the church?
5. The message challenged us to move from being consumers of ministry to participants in God's mission. Is there an area where you sense God inviting you to step in, serve, or take greater ownership? What makes that exciting or challenging for you?
6. What is one specific need, opportunity, or person God might be placing in front of you? What would it look like to take a step forward to help rather than just noticing the need?
7. How can we pray for you this week? Is there a burden, challenge, or opportunity where you need God's wisdom, strength, or encouragement?
