This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

- 1. What's a specific memory or experience you have with your earthly father (or a father figure) that has significantly shaped your perception of God as a Father? How did that experience make you feel about the idea of God being a Father?
- 2. This week's message was *Is God Really a Good Father?* Let's read the key Scripture passage for this week about the prodigal son: Luke 15:11-24. What caught your attention in the message? What impacted you?
- **3.** Let's read Psalm 34:18. How does this verse reinforce the image of God as a loving Father, especially for those who have felt wounded or distant? In what ways do you think God draws near when we are hurting or ashamed?
- **4.** Let's read Galatians 4:6–7. How does the idea of God adopting us and placing His Spirit in us change the way we view Him as Father? How is this different from a relationship based on fear or performance?
- 5. The parable of the prodigal son shows a father who runs to meet his disgraced son, full of compassion. The message emphasized that this reveals the father's heart. Let's read Romans 8:15. In what areas of your life do you still struggle to fully embrace God as your loving "Abba, Father," similar to the father in the prodigal son story? What makes it hard to believe He sees you with compassion and not condemnation?
- **6.** Considering all we discussed about God's true nature as a loving Father, what's one specific step you can take this week to intentionally lean into His fatherly love and trust Him more, even in areas where you've previously felt distant or fearful?
