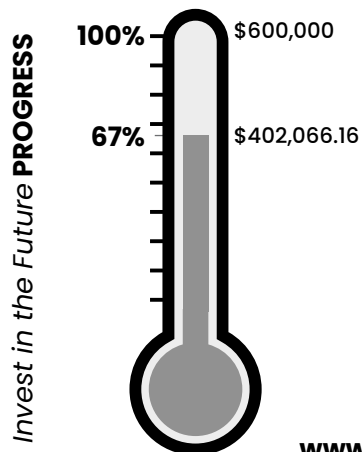

For group discussion the week of July 5

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

1. Think about a time when someone unexpectedly helped, encouraged, or guided you at just the right moment. What happened, and why has it stuck with you?
2. This week's message was *The Spirit of Evangelism*. Let's read Acts 8:26-40. Was there a part of the message — or something in this passage — that stood out to you or that you sensed God highlighting?
3. Let's read Acts 8:29-35. Philip listened to the Spirit's leading and stepped into a conversation that God had already prepared. What do you notice about Philip's response, and what does it teach us about joining God in what He's already doing?
4. In John 16:7-11, Jesus said the Holy Spirit works in people's hearts before we ever speak. What does this show us about God's heart for people, and how does it change the way we think about sharing our faith?
5. Is there someone God has been bringing to your mind lately? What hopes, fears, or hesitations do you have when it comes to talking with them about Jesus?
6. What's one simple step you could take this week to be more available to the Holy Spirit — whether that's praying for someone, starting a conversation, inviting someone to church, or simply listening for God's leading?
7. Before we finish, how can we pray for you this week? Is there a person you'd like us to pray for as you seek to follow the Spirit's leading?
