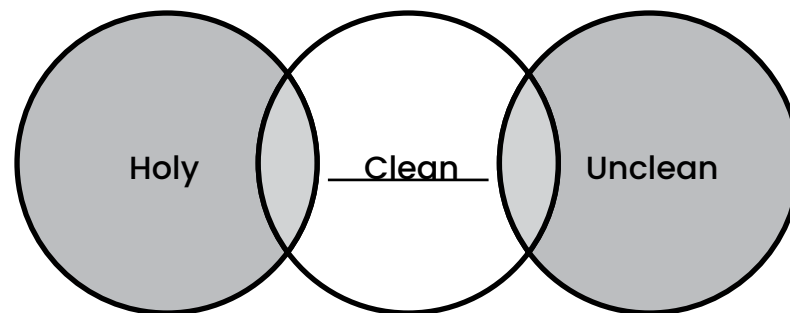

For group discussion the week of July 19

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

1. Let's start with something fun. Think of a time when someone unexpectedly welcomed you or included you. What happened, and how did it make you feel?
2. This week's message was *Invitation, Not Insulation*. Let's read Acts 10:25-35. Was there a part of the message or Scripture that especially grabbed your attention or challenged the way you think?
3. Peter discovered that God was already at work in Cornelius' life before Peter ever arrived. Now let's read John 4:35-38. Jesus says the fields are "ripe for harvest." What do you notice about God's role and our role in reaching people?
4. Let's also read 2 Corinthians 5:17-20. Paul says we are Christ's ambassadors. What does this passage show us about God's heart for people and the way He wants His followers to represent Him?
5. Peter had to let God expose prejudice and assumptions that had quietly settled into his heart. Is there a person or group that you find difficult to love, understand, or move toward with compassion? What do you think God might be inviting you to see differently?
6. This week, who is one person God may be inviting you to intentionally notice, encourage, serve, or pray for? What's one simple step you can take to reflect Christ's grace toward them?
7. Before we wrap up, how can we pray for you this week? Is there a burden you're carrying or a relationship where you need God's wisdom, courage, or grace?

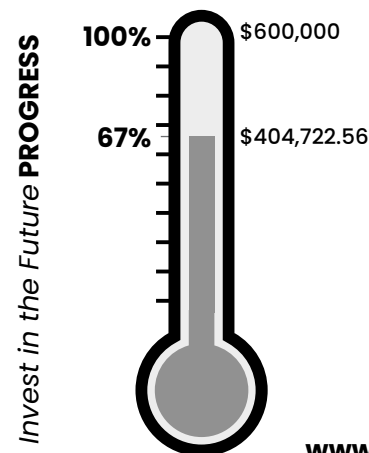
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
