For group discussion the week of September 7

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

- 1. What's a moment in your life when someone spoke words of affirmation over you that really stuck? How did it make you feel, and what impact did it have on your sense of identity?
- 2. This week's message was Secure Foundation. Let's read the key Scripture passage for this week: Luke 3:21–22. What caught your attention in the message? What impacted you personally?
- 3. In the message, we heard that Jesus received His identity, love, and approval from the Father before doing any ministry. Let's read 1 John 3:1. Why do you think it's so hard for us to rest in our identity that we are already children of God?
- **4.** Let's read Hebrews 4:15. Jesus was prepared for temptation by becoming familiar with the Father's voice. What does it mean to you that Jesus understands your temptations and struggles? How might this shape the way you approach times of testing or spiritual battles?
- 5. Jesus didn't need to prove anything to the enemy because He was secure in the Father's love. Let's read Romans 8:16–17. Are there areas in your life right now where you feel you need to "prove" your worth or identity to God, to others, or even to yourself? What lies are hardest for you to silence?
- **6.** Jesus resisted the adversary by using Scripture He had hidden in His heart. What is one verse or truth from Scripture you could memorize or meditate on this week that reminds you of your identity in Christ?
