

For group discussion the week of September 21

This Study Guide is designed to help you apply Sunday's message. Join a Life Group and do this study together!

- 1. Share a time when someone asked you to do something that felt risky, inconvenient, or weird but you said "yes" anyway. What was the moment like, and what surprised you about the outcome?
- 2. This week's message was *The Invitation to Discipleship*. Let's read the key passage: Luke 5:1–11. What caught your attention in the message or passage? What landed in your heart or made you think differently?
- 3. Simon felt unworthy, but Jesus still called him. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26–29. How does the truth that God often calls imperfect, ordinary people change the way you think about your own potential to follow Jesus? Share a time you felt unqualified but were surprised by what God did.
- **4.** This week's message pushed us to consider the cost of following Jesus. Read Luke 14:28–33. What fears or practical concerns come up for you when you imagine leaving behind something comfortable to follow Jesus more fully?
- 5. Simon's first instinct was to hide because he felt unworthy. Read Romans 8:38–39. Where do you find yourself pulling back from Jesus because of shame, fear, or a sense of unworthiness? If you're willing, share one specific example and how that feeling affects decisions you make about following God.
- **6.** Choose one small, concrete step you will take this week to "trust and obey" in a place where you've been holding back. What is that step for you? What will motivate you to follow through with this step forward?
