



Respect Ambassadors

All Girls and Womens teams are given Respect Vests by the Alan Boswell Group Cambridgeshire Girls and Women's Football League.

Wearing Respect Vests shows our commitment as a club to following the FA Respect Campaign, and that we will keep to the FA Respect Codes. The parent/spectator who wears the vest as a Respect Ambassador is asked to be present in a **non-confrontational role**, to provide support to the referee in maintaining Respect standards. This may include:

- Ensuring that our own spectators comply with the Respect line/designated spectators' area.
- Reminding our own supporters of responsibilities in relation to Respect towards match officials.
- Supporting the Referee when dealing with any spectator related issue within our own team.
- Being a visible point of contact for any concerns from the opposition's Respect Steward.

The referee, or assistants, may ask you to report a spectator's poor behaviour to the club if it falls below acceptable standards.
