



Respect Stewards

All teams from U12 to U18 are given Respect Vests by the Colts League. One green vest is to be worn by the linesman, one orange vest is to be worn by a parent or spectator as a Respect Steward.

Wearing Respect Vests shows our commitment as a club to following the FA Respect Campaign, and that we will keep to the FA Respect Codes. The parent/spectator who wears the orange vest as a Respect Steward is asked to be present in a **non-confrontational role**, to provide support to the referee in maintaining Respect standards. This may include:

- Ensuring that our own spectators comply with the Respect line/designated spectators' area.
- Reminding our own supporters of responsibilities in relation to Respect towards match officials.
- Supporting the Referee when dealing with any spectator related issue within our own team.
- Being a visible point of contact for any concerns from the opposition's Respect Steward.

The referee, or assistants, may ask you to report a spectator's poor behaviour to the club if it falls below acceptable standards.
