At our annual Smart Futures dinner, we experienced record-breaking attendance and funds raised to support our Club operations. In the fall, we were overjoyed to celebrate a ribbon cutting at our newly-named Wayne Bank Unit, formerly known as the Western Wayne Unit. Serving over 100 different youth in the Cambridge City area has been a huge success, and we can't wait for this number to continue to grow.

**We are so grateful for our dedicated, professional staff who show up daily to make our mission come to life.** In 2022, we put a major focus on professional development for our staff members. Training included Trust-Based Relationship Intervention (TBRI), a well-being project that focuses on the eight dimensions of wellness and sending our staff to numerous trainings and conferences across the state and country. Investing in our staff members allows us to have more qualified, trained adults to teach our young people.

2023 will continue to bring deep impact for those in our community. Our West End Charitable Foundation Professional Development Training Center will allow for additional space to train our staff. We are elated to reopen The CLUB Teen Center at our McDaniel Unit after a major renovation project which has made this space more appealing and accommodating for our teens. **We will continue to dive deep into addressing the changing needs of our youth;** including kicking off a workforce development training program, continuing to focus on social emotional learning, and focusing on the goals we have created in our newly adopting five-year strategic plan.

**Our impact is not possible without your support.** Thank you to our Wayne County community members, partners, staff, board, trustees and everyone else who supports our organization and the youth we serve. **Every child deserves to have a safe place to attend after school, and, with your help, this is possible!**

## 2022 Youth of the Year & Scholarship Winners



During our Spring Spotlight, BGCWC announced our **2022 Youth of the Year, Carly P.** (pictured). Carly is currently a junior at Richmond High School and has been a member of BGCWC for five years.

“The Club has become a second family to me,” Carly noted. “The staff at the Club have always made me feel wanted, needed, and valued.”

In addition to the award, Carly received a \$1,000 scholarship and advanced to compete for Indiana State Youth of the Year where she placed in the top five, received an additional scholarship, and was offered a free semester at **Ivy Tech**!

The Club also awarded Richmond High School seniors **Amyia Farris** and **Wesley Phillips** with the **Jack Reed Memorial Scholarship** during our Spring Spotlight. Both students received \$2,000 from the Jack Reed Memorial Scholarship and an additional \$1,000 from the **Ivy Tech Foundation** to continue their education post high school. Amyia intends to pursue a career in the medical field and Wesley plans to study engineering.

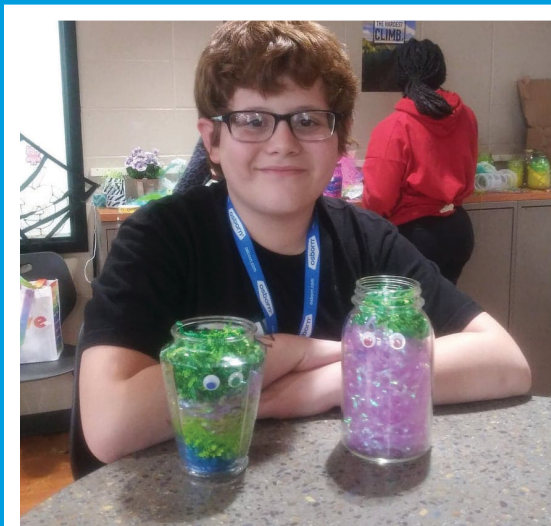
