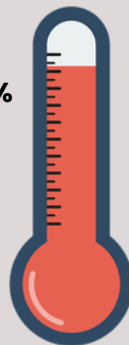

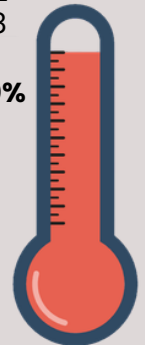

Second Year of Parish Families – July 2026

This July marks the second year since the formation of parish families through Partners in the Gospel - the strategic pastoral planning process to re-envision parish life and renew our local Catholic Church.

Over the past year, parish families formed their Parish Family Advisory Councils, comprised of lay volunteers, and Parish Family Leadership Teams, comprised of staff from each parish in a parish family. Together these groups began the One Parish Planning Process, which is grounded in listening, community discernment and local decision-making to develop both a vision for the future and a plan to execute it. Hundreds of listening sessions have taken place across the region, with parishioners sharing their experiences and identifying the gifts and charism of each parish in their family.

At the same time, many parish families are working together in new ways, such as combining faith formation programs and vocations ministries. Parish families brought their communities together to celebrate the liturgical seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter. This year, pastors met in February for a two-day retreat focused on Partners in the Gospel. Parochial Vicars met in May. At each retreat, they prayed, shared their experiences and learned from each other.

The good news is that the Holy Spirit is at work in our parish families: Mass counts are up, with a 4.5% increase year-over-year. And there was a significant increase in Catholics coming into the Church in our archdiocese at Easter, with over 1,000 catechumens and 522 candidates for full communion.

As we enter year three, parish families will continue working through the One Parish Planning process, with the goal of finalizing their plan in 2027.

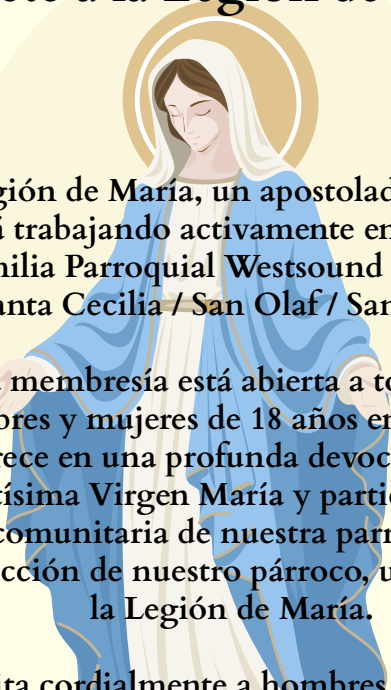
Únete a la Legión de María

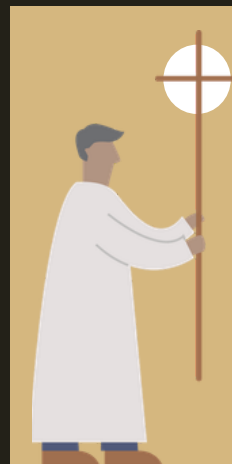



Empathy, Explained!

The virtue of empathy describes our ability to connect emotionally with the suffering of others. It's our interior capacity to appreciate and experience other people's feelings — to the extent, even, that we allow those feelings to impact our own decisions and our own actions.

Christ had empathy for us and for our state of imprisonment in original sin. He had empathy for the suffering we endure because of our self-imposed exile from friendship with God. This empathy meant that he sacrificed himself willingly for our salvation — he wanted to do it, because he had allowed our feelings to intermingle with his own.

Since empathy flows directly from charity, the theological virtue that enables us to love God and to love others, we can use charity as a way to increase the empathy we feel. If we find ourselves struggling to muster empathy in a particular situation, engaging in charity will liberate us from our state of self-centeredness.

O God,
As You rested after the creation of the world, remind us to take a sacred pause, too. Surround and support us with Your love, help us to practice holy rest — a practice that renews and recreates.
