LOCATION:	Amazon Pool 2600 Hilyard Eugene, OR 97405
FACILITY:	50-meter outdoor pool, 8-lane, with 9 feet wide lanes. 25-yard outdoor 2 lane warm-up and cool down pool. Depth 3.6-13.2 ft. Starting blocks at the deep end. Touchpads at both ends. Colorado timing system. The facility has accessibility for adaptive swimmers. The facility and team will assure these dimensions are correct.
CONCESSIONS:	We will have a potluck for this meet! Please bring favorite treats or snacks for your athlete to share with other athletes, coaches and officials.

OFFICIALS:	<p>TEAM officials, please use our website's volunteer page to sign up to officiate.</p> <p>We always appreciate the help of certified officials from other clubs. If you will be attending this meet, please use this form to sign up at least one week before the meet: https://forms.gle/ug9PFg5nTMF5Yhku9</p> <p>All referees, starters, administrative officials, electronic timing officials, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in this sanctioned event, must be members of USA Swimming. The officials' uniform will be white shirts, black shorts/pants/skirt with black shoes.</p>
ELIGIBILITY:	<p>Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. No on deck meet registration will be permitted. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of the first day of the meet.</p>
HOSPITALITY:	<p>We will have a potluck for this meet! Athlete families will bring favorite treats or snacks to share with other athletes, coaches and officials. <i>We highly encourage coaches and officials to bring their own water bottle. We will have refill stations available.</i></p>
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES:	<p>Swimmers with disabilities are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.</p>
ENTRIES:	<p><i>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit LCM times only for seeding. NT will be accepted • Submit entries via E-mail in a Hy-Tek formatted file in addition to a PDF entry list by name. Please submit payment after entries have been confirmed. • Submit entries to: meetdirector@teameugene.org • With submission of entries the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.
ENTRY DEADLINE:	<p>We will begin accepting entries at 12:00 PM on April 2, 2026 Teams are encouraged to submit entries as close to this time as possible to ensure entrance into the meet. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received and will be limited to four hours per session.</p> <p>Updates will be accepted until 11:59 PM on May 4, 2026 Updated entries are subject to time constraints and not guaranteed - please contact meetdirector@teameugene.org before submitting a revised entry file.</p> <p>All final entries must be received no later than 11:59 PM on May 4, 2026 Final events may be adjusted to assure we adhere to time constraints.</p>
ENTRY LIMIT	<p>Limit of 3 individual events and 1 relay per session.</p>

NO COACH PRESENT:	For unattached swimmers or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmer’s responsibility to arrange for a certified coach to be responsible for the swimmer. This must be done BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition. Please see the Meet Director or the Meet Referee if assistance is needed upon arrival at the meet.		
WARM-UP:	<p>Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures are in effect at this meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Warm-up lanes may be assigned depending on the number of swimmers entered. There is a second small pool available for general warm-up as well. The small pool will also be available through the meet for warm-up and cool down. ● Start and pace lanes will be determined based on need during each session. <p>Note: Swimmers violating safety procedures may be removed from the warm-up for the remainder of the warm-up session. Subsequent violations may cause the swimmer to be removed from the remainder of the meet.</p>

TIMELINE:	<p>The Meet Director and Meet Referee reserves the right to change warm-up and start times if needed. All coaches will be informed of any changes to warm-up and competition times. The Meet Director and Meet Referee reserve the right to remove or lengthen breaks written in the sanction as deemed appropriate for the success of the athletes and officials.</p> <p>Entries will be limited to adhere to the 4 hour rule. Breaks may be added at the discretion of the meet referee. For individual events 400 yards and longer, heats may be limited to adhere to the 4 hour rule. Limits will be based on the order in which entries are received.</p> <p>Timelines are for reference only and the meet may be running ahead or behind the timeline. Swimmers are responsible for getting to their heat in time for the start.</p>		
HEAT SHEETS:	Heat sheets will be emailed to team coaches prior to the meet. Printed copies will be available at the meet for officials and coaches.		
MEETINGS:	<p>Officials’ meetings will be held 1 hour prior to the start of each session.</p> <p>Coaches’ meetings will be held, if needed, 15 min prior to the start of each session.</p>		



TIMERS:	<p>The meet will be run with two manual watches and buttons per lane in addition to a fully automated timing system. We will need volunteer timers from each team. Timing sign ups can be found near the spectator entrance.</p>
RULES & SAFETY:	<p>Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet. All walkways around the pool and lifeguard stations must be kept clear. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual.</p> <p>Oregon Scratch Rules will not be enforced for this meet, however we would greatly appreciate notification of all scratches ahead of time.</p> <p>Oregon Swimming Safety Rules and Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet.</p> <p>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</p> <p>Medical supervision will be provided by facility lifeguards.</p>
FORMAT:	<p>All Sessions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timed finals swum combined age and gender. • All events 800 and above swum fast to slow. Everything else swum slow to fast. • All events 400 and above deck-seeded, everything else pre-seeded. Positive check-ins for events 400 and longer due 30 minutes after start of warm-ups.
DECK SEEDING AND SCRATCHES:	<p>Individual Events/Relays: Please declare false start or scratch before an event if entered but not swimming.</p> <p>Deck Seeded Events: Positive check-in by coach/athlete due 30 minutes after start of warmups. Check-ins will take place at the clerk of course. If an athlete does not check in they will not be seeded into the event.</p> <p>Relays: Relay slips may be turned in to meet office beforehand, or brought to timers behind the block prior to the event.</p>

<p>RESTRICTIONS:</p>	<p>No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet. Tobacco, non-tobacco, vapor products of any kind, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue. NO SHAVING PERMITTED in the venue. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Please change in designated changing areas or locker rooms only. No cell phones or other recording devices are allowed behind the blocks. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</p>
