Reading, Writing and Phonics

- Reading at home is essential. Please record a comment in the reading record. Children who read at least x4 a week will earn a house point and children who read regularly will receive a certificate and will be entered into a prize raffle at the end of term.
- In English, we will be reading the lovely traditional story 'Old Bear' by Jane Hissey and we write our own rescue stories of how to get Old Bear down from the attic.
- The children will have daily phonics lessons. They will learn to recognise sounds, and read and write them. They will learn to blend and segment whole words and read them in sentences.



In Geography, we will look at aerial maps where we will locate features and also create our own aerial maps of the classroom and school grounds. We will conduct a survey of the playground and from the results, we will decide what we need to improve!
