


Come Make a Joyful Noise!

Empower Guatemala – Stove and Water Filter Ministry Extending God's Love Through Service

Impacting Lives and Building Community

The resources we gather, both financial and practical, are truly the heartbeat of our ministry, enabling us to stand alongside families in need and to tangibly demonstrate God's love. Equally crucial is the steadfast work carried out by our partners: the pastor and the local church in Guatemala. We are deeply grateful for their unwavering dedication; together, we accomplish far more than we ever could alone. All thanks and praise be to God!

Our mission reaches far beyond simply providing stoves and water filters. This coming January, we are set to serve an incredible 486 families, each averaging six members, touching nearly 3,000 lives in total. In addition to these essential installations, we'll be delivering close to 100 checked bags filled with everyday necessities: LuoPads, medicines, prenatal and children's vitamins, reading glasses, children's books in English to support language learning, clothing, and many other practical items. While some of these donations will directly benefit the 486 families receiving stoves and water filters, many will be distributed across several communities, ensuring that those facing the greatest challenges are not forgotten.

The pastor skillfully uses these resources to build trust and strengthen relationships with surrounding communities, creating new opportunities to offer hope and to share the message of the Gospel.

Witnessing our increasing effectiveness is genuinely uplifting. Year after year, our reach grows, allowing us to help even more families. Yet, as our mission expands, so does our need for financial support.

Your prayers, generous contributions, and ongoing financial support truly make this mission possible. When we embrace God's call to serve with open hearts, we see His blessings multiply in astonishing ways.

IRA Giving: QCD & RMD

If you're 70½ or older, you may be eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from your IRA—tax-free. This is especially beneficial starting the year you turn 73, when you're required to take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

By making a donation directly from your IRA, you can fulfill your RMD while potentially lowering your taxable income.
