

WATER WELL PERMIT PROCEDURES FOR THE HOMEOWNER

BEFORE DRILLING THE WELL

- Use the Site Plan form provided to sketch a diagram. Please take the form home, locate the sources of potential contamination and measure the distances from the proposed well location. Return this form with the completed Water Well Application.
- Complete the Private Water Well Permit Application, sign and date the application, return the application with the appropriate fee.(\$250)
- Please note that the Well Driller and Pump Installer must be registered by the Ohio Department of Health. You can confirm their status at www.odh.ohio.gov, and search for "List of Registered Private Water contractors located in Ohio."
- Homeowners must become registered as private water system contractors in order to install well pumps/pit-less adapters or to seal an abandoned well.

AFTER THE WELL HAS BEEN DRILLED

- Provide "Job Status / Completion Form" to person who is going to install the pump and check to verify that the form has been returned to the Health Department within thirty days of completion
- Verify that the Well Driller/Pump installer have chlorinated the well
- Call the Auglaize County Health Department to request a water sample.(419-738-3410)
- Water Samples need to be taken from the pressure tank or first available raw water tap, arrangements will need to be made to allow sanitarians access to the pressure tank.
