One of the best things you can do is sit quietly at Mass and listen to and join in the prayers.

At every Mass we hear God's Word, God is speaking to us. We listen to a special message from God's book, which is called the Holy Bible. And we hear the Good News about Jesus from a part of the Bible called the Gospel.

Jesus is with us at Mass. He offers Himself to God the Father at every Mass, just as He did on Good Friday. We can offer ourselves with Jesus too.

At every Mass, we should remember the Last Supper that Jesus had with the Apostles and how He changed the bread and wine into His Body and Blood. God has given priests the power to do what Jesus did.

When the priest takes bread in his hands and says "This is my Body" it becomes the Body of Jesus. And when he takes the cup of wine in his hands and says "This is the chalice of my Blood" it becomes the Blood of Jesus. We do not see Jesus on the altar, but He is really there. Jesus is God and He can do anything.
