He became the man Whom we call Jesus and Who died to save us from sin. God the Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity.

The three Persons of the Blessed Trinity had no **beginning**. They always were and always will be.





One of the best things you can do is sit **quietly** at Mass and listen to and join in the **prayers**.

At every Mass we hear God's <u>Word</u>, God is speaking to us. We listen to a special <u>message</u> from God's book, which is called the <u>Holy</u>
<u>Bible</u>. And we hear the <u>Good</u>
<u>News</u> about <u>Jesus</u> from a part of the Bible called the <u>Gospel</u>.

Jesus is with us at <u>Mass</u>. He offers <u>Himself</u> to God the <u>Father</u> at every Mass, just as He did on Good <u>Friday</u>. We can offer ourselves with Jesus too.

At every Mass, we should remember the Last Supper that Jesus had with the Apostles and how He changed the bread and wine into His Body and Blood. God has given priests the power to do what Jesus did.

When the priest takes bread in his hands and says "This is my **Body**" it becomes the Body of Jesus. And when he takes the cup of wine in his hands and says "This is the chalice of my **Blood**" it becomes the Blood of Jesus. We do not see **Jesus** on the **altar**, but He is really there. Jesus is **God** and He can do anything.






