Stockgrowers' Legislative Issues

Our Brand Board bill is up it is HB 1252. We had some challenges and some missed connections in the bill introduction process. That's why that bill appears as it does. The meat of the bill is in the amendment posted at the bottom of the page. Also, we still need to add the pieces regarding Brand Board location and the requirement for a Chief Brand Inspector. The development of the language for the holds formula was not able to be completed by bill introduction deadline. We knew that, but a path I relied on to extend the time to develop that language was closed almost as quick as it opened. We're still pursuing those items.

HB 1145 which includes the low hanging fruit items relative to the Brand Program to which all parties agreed passed out of the Ag Committee this week.

A final version of the foreign ownership or control of agricultural land (FOAL) bill has been introduced. That is HB 1231. That changes very little as a practical matter. The consensus among the Ag groups is it doesn't do harm and they are neutral.

Monday the House Commerce Committee will hear five bills relative to landowner rights/pipeline. That agenda is here.
