Stockgrowers' Legislative Issues

SB 171, an act to provide a landowner-on-own-land license for antlerless elk, will be heard at 7:45 tomorrow morning in House Ag. committee. The bill permits GF&P to issue a landowner-on-own-land license that authorizes the holder to take one antlerless elk, from land owned or leased by the holder, for agricultural purposes, within a designated unit, during the prairie elk hunting season.

On the property rights/pipeline/eminent domain front SB 201 passed the Senate last week. That bill strips all local control over any gas or liquid transmission line or electric transmission line which requires or holds a permit under chapter 49-41B. Counties, municipalities, and townships would be barred from imposing any requirement or restrictions as to routing, setback, construction, operation, maintenance, and zoning permits. The bill would void any existing local requirements in those areas. SB 201 will be heard by the House Commerce Committee this morning.
