1	Additional risks are anything that increases the risk factor associated with boating, eg. strong winds, fog.					
2	ALL crew boats to be steered by senior steersperson or senior cox OR accompanied by launch					
3	These criteria relate to CLUB BOATS. The use of private boats is at the owner's discretion. However, if private owners rely on club insurance they will not be covered if they boat against these rules					
4	ARC retains the right to shut the pontoon completely and prevent all boating.					
5	Conditions should be continuously assessed and the outing cut short if conditions become unsafe.					
6	Boats requiring to be accompanied by launch or other boat must remain within sight and sound of the launch or other boat
